MISSION STATEMENT:

St. Ignatius College Preparatory is a Catholic, Jesuit school serving the San Francisco Bay Area since 1855. Through a rigorous and integrated program of academic, spiritual, and co-curricular activities, St. Ignatius challenges its students to lead lives of faith, integrity, and compassion. Students are enriched by a diverse and loving Christian community and are called to become life-long learners who develop their individual talents for the greater glory of God. PRIMARY ROLE:

The St. Ignatius Athletic Department hosts a three-level program in football and competes in the West Catholic Athletic League (WCAL). The head coach works with the Assistant Principal for Student Affairs and Athletic Director to recruit, hire and supervise 17 assistant coaches and 170 student-athletes (*Fall 2024 roster*). The high school football league season runs from August 5 - December 17. The head coach schedules all contests and must be well versed in WCAL, CCS, and CIF rules and regulations.

The head coach will work with the Athletic Department Staff and plan a year-round performance plan, Spring football and summer workouts. Full time on campus, or off-campus stipend packages will be discussed during the interview process.

St. Ignatius has an on-campus, synthetic turf field and hosts all practices on campus. The ten (10) game league schedule and five (5) potential playoff games will be played both at SI and at various high schools in the bay area. Home games are played on Friday nights and the team will practice 6 days a week, with no practices or team meetings on Sunday.

- Experience working, playing or coaching in a value-based athletic program

- Special emphasis on leading and mentoring the football program throughout the year
- Desire to work with adolescents and help develop them as positive leaders and teammates
- Foster a team atmosphere with inclusionary, compassionate, and restorative practices that are in alignment with our school mission
- Market and promote SI's football program in the community, proactively attracting prospective student-athletes and their families
- Able and willing to attend non-football related school events
- Appropriate and effective use of social media to promote athletic events
- Excellent in-person and electronic communication and organizational skills
