STUDENTS

Pupil Interviews with Other Than Parent or Guardian

I. Interviews with Students

A. Interviews, with students, during the day on the school grounds, *by other than the parent/guardian and school* personnel, shall be permitted, subject to the following qualifications:

1. Interviews with a parent will be permitted if such an interview would not be a violation of a Court Order.
2. Interview by law enforcement officials:

The principal shall authorize an interview of a student by a juvenile probation or parole officer if such an interview is being conducted pursuant to an order of the Juvenile Court.

- a. The principal of his/her designee may authorize an interview by a law enforcement official who is investigating an offense, if the student is a victim or a witness to an offense.
 - b. The principal or his/her designee shall be responsible for notifying the parent/guardian of the interview.
 - c. The principal or his/her designee shall sit in on the interview.
 - d. The principal or his designee shall record the time, date, and content of the interview.
3. Interview with other public agencies:
 - a. Such interviews shall be at the discretion of the principal or his/her designee.
 - b. Such representatives shall be adequately identified and the purpose of the interview stated.
 - c. The principal or his/her designee shall notify the parent/guardian of the interview.

- d. The principal or his/her designee shall be present at the interview.
 - e. The principal or his/her designee shall record the time, date and content of the interview.
4. Exceptions to section 2. c, d and e and 3.d and e, will be cases of suspected child abuse or neglect, molestation, drug abuse, where no attempt to contact parent is required.
