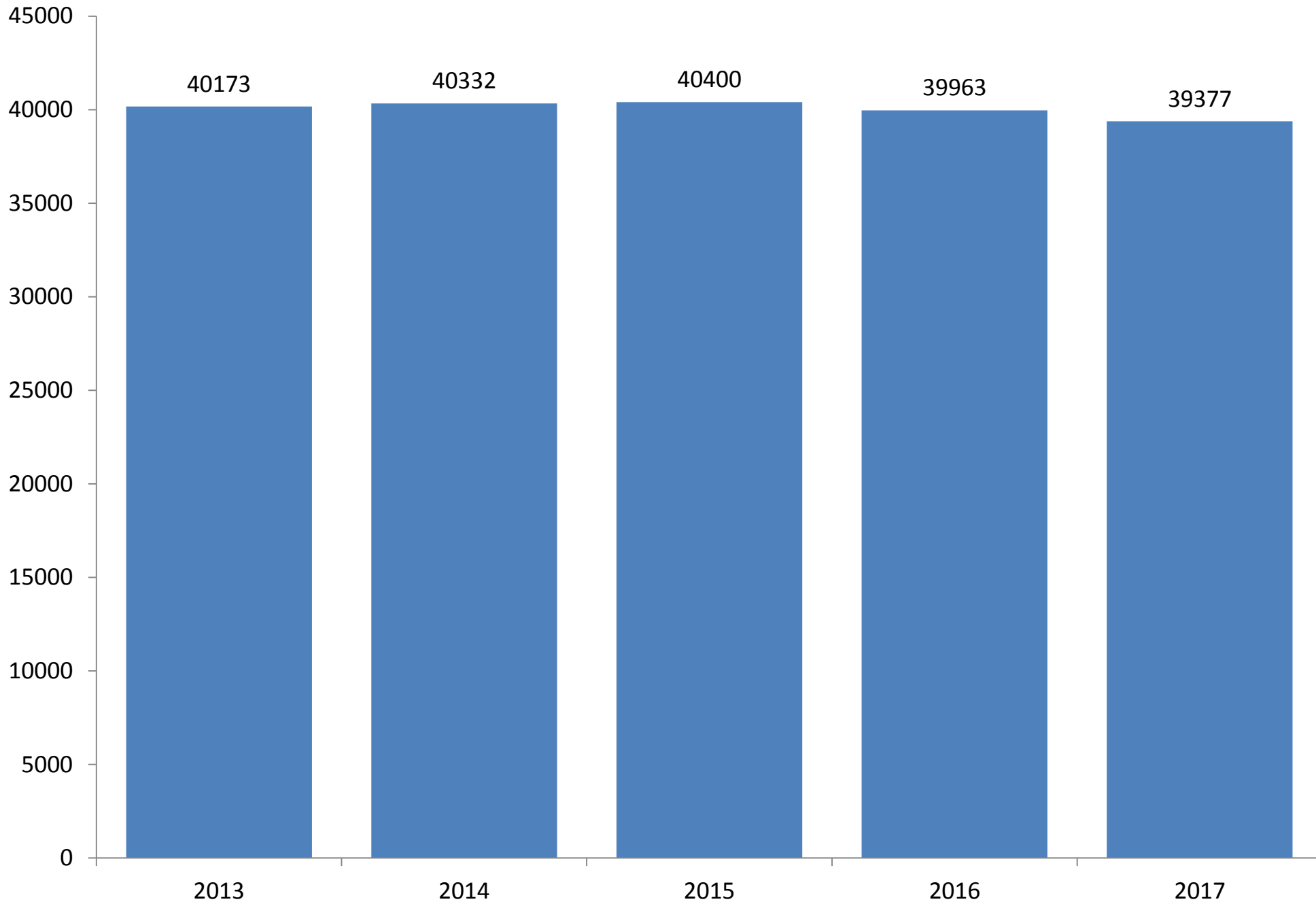

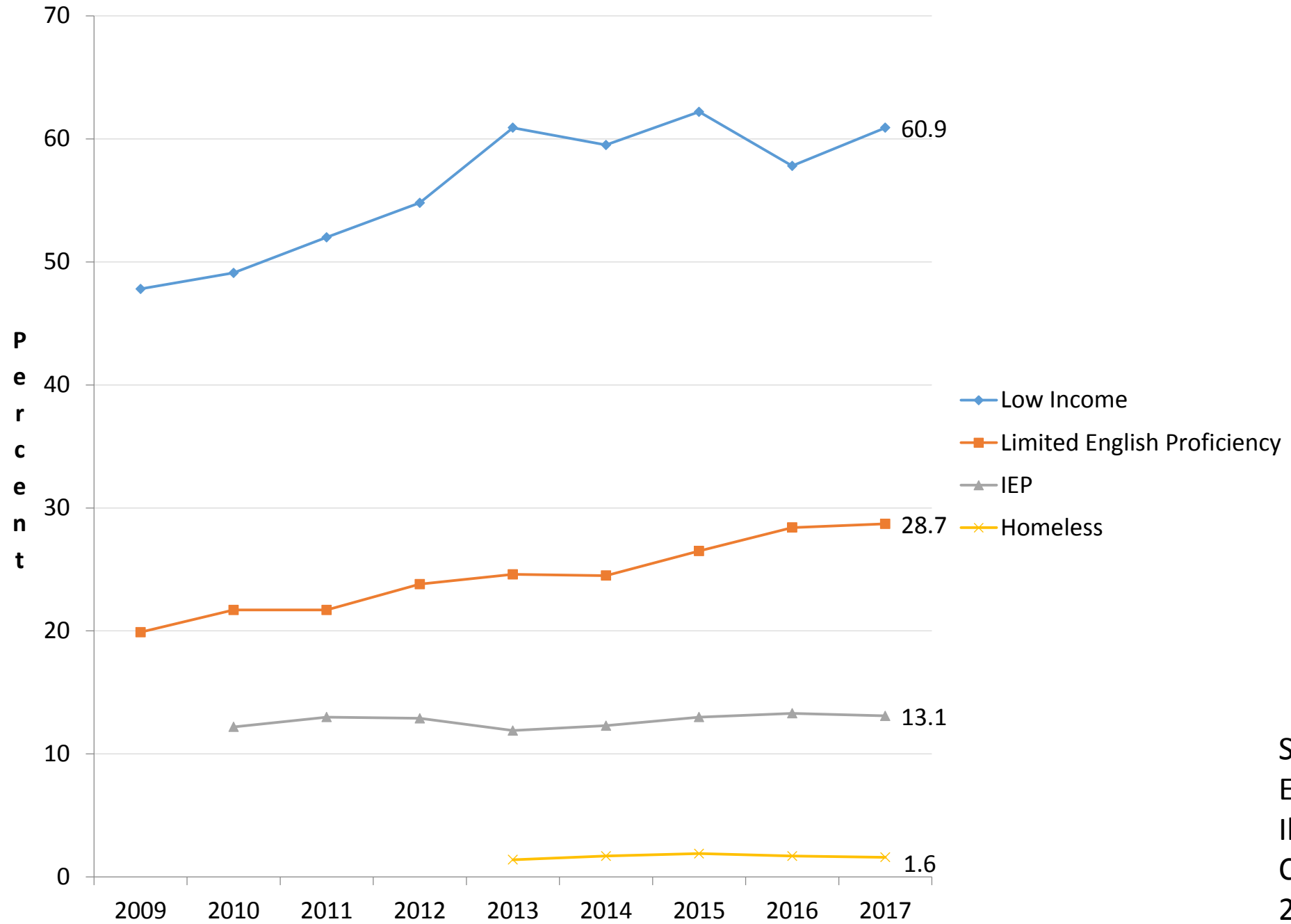

Total Enrollment



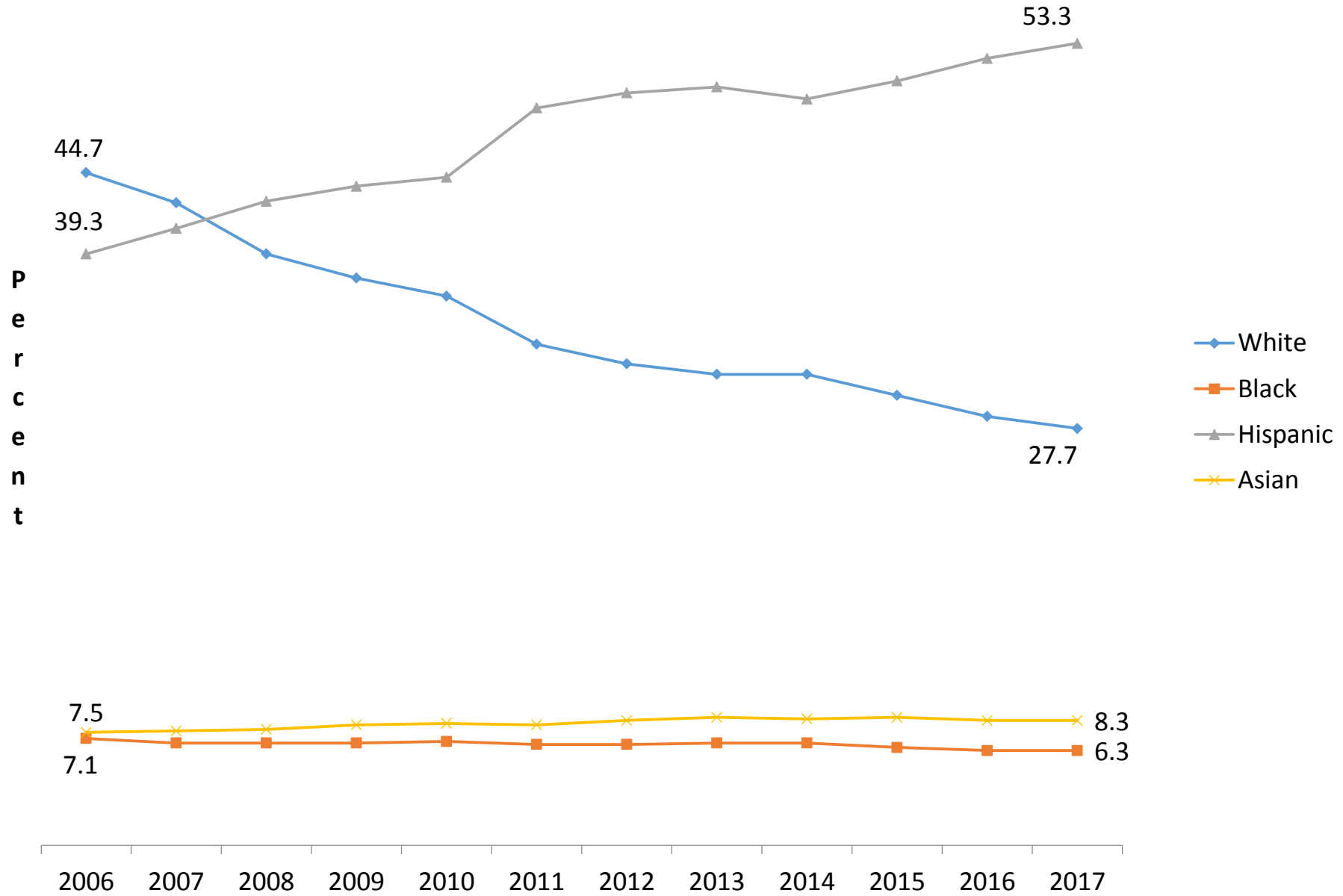

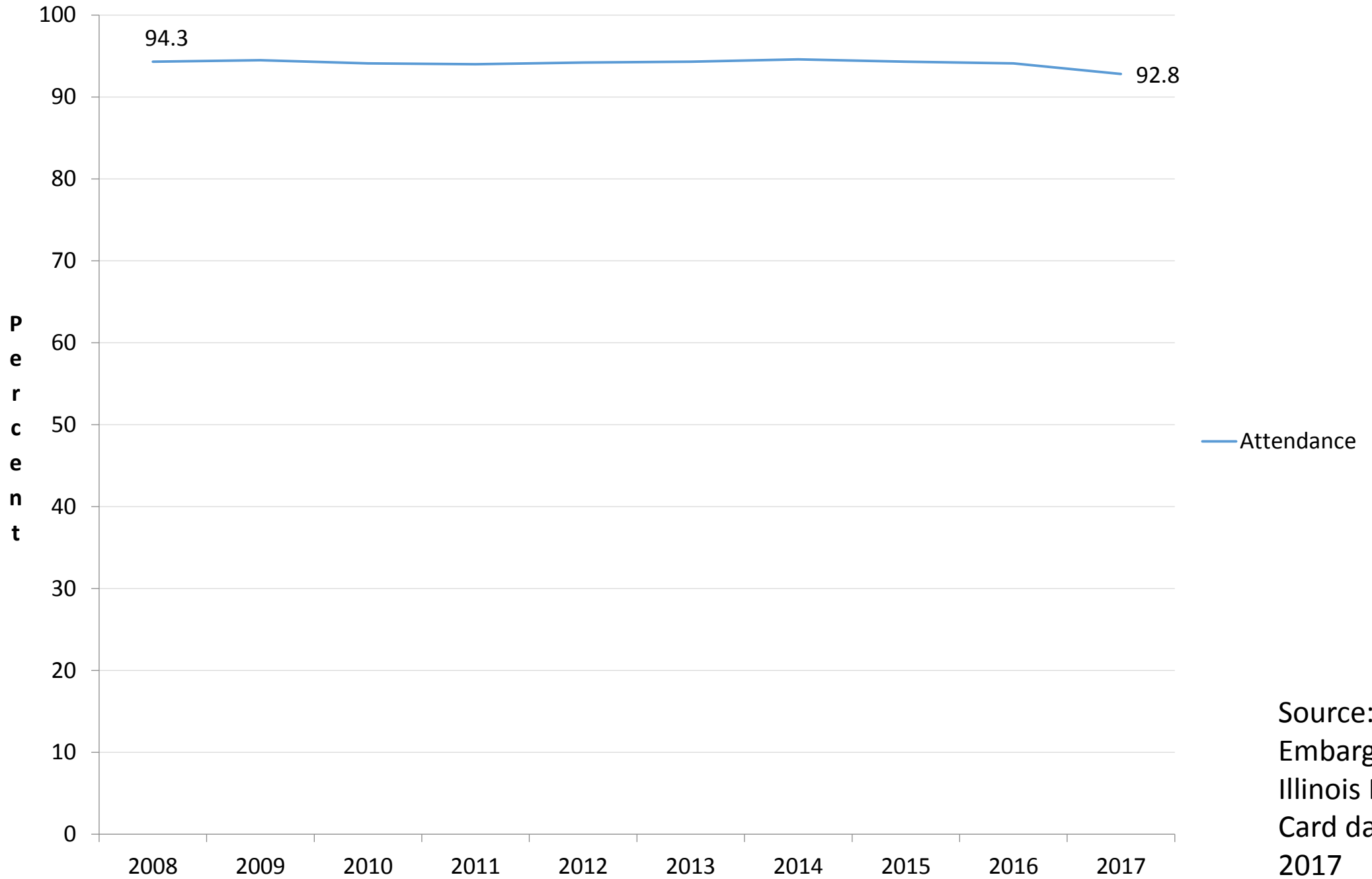

U-46 Race/Ethnicity Profile



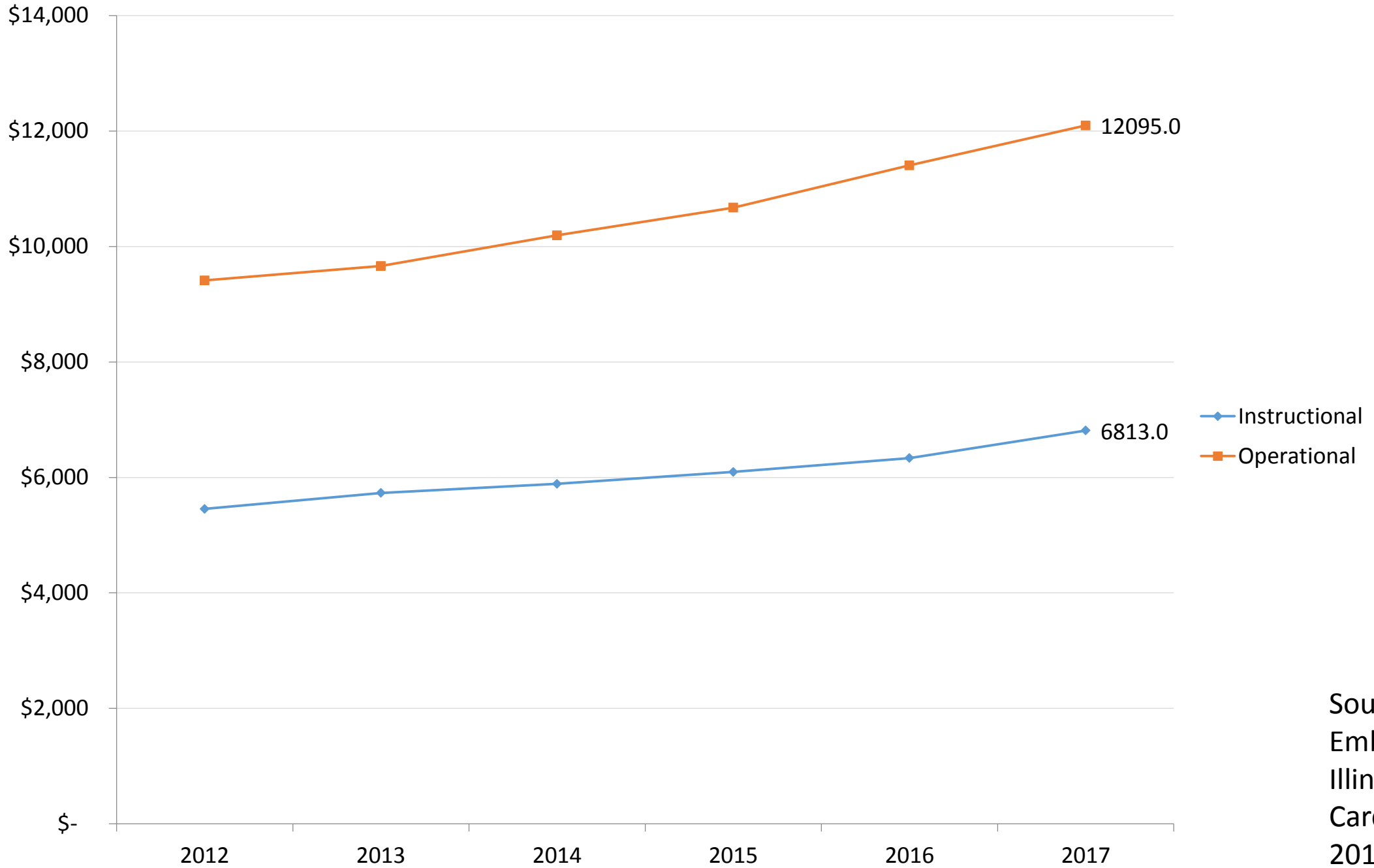

Expenditures Per Pupil

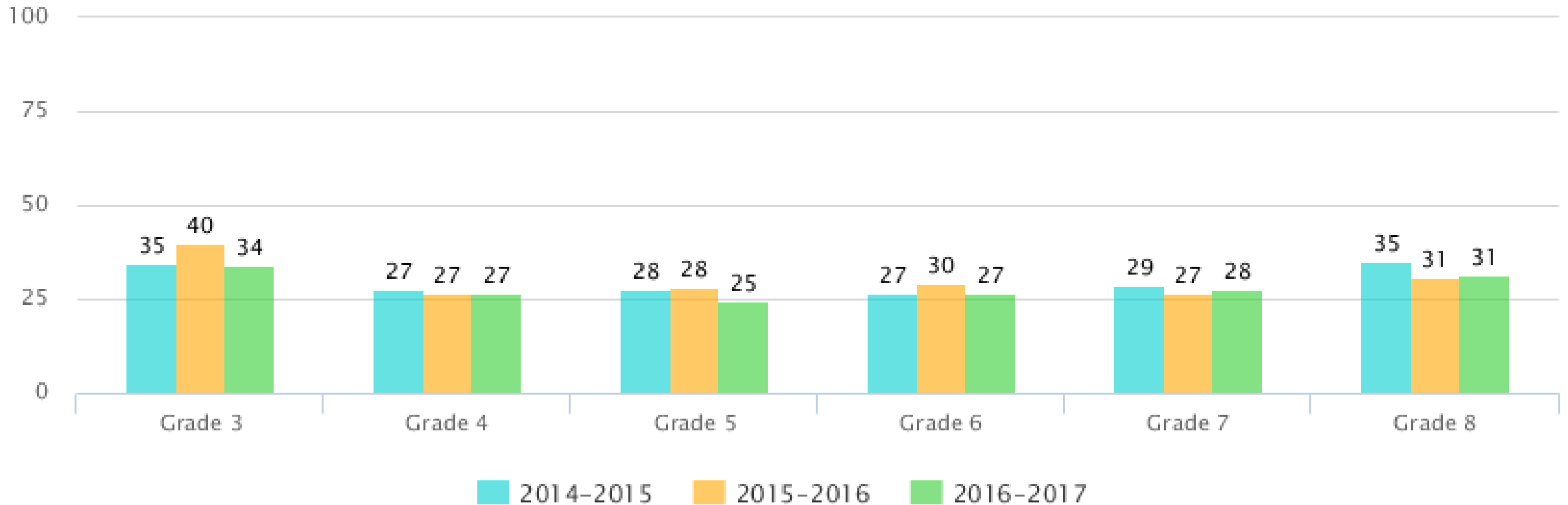

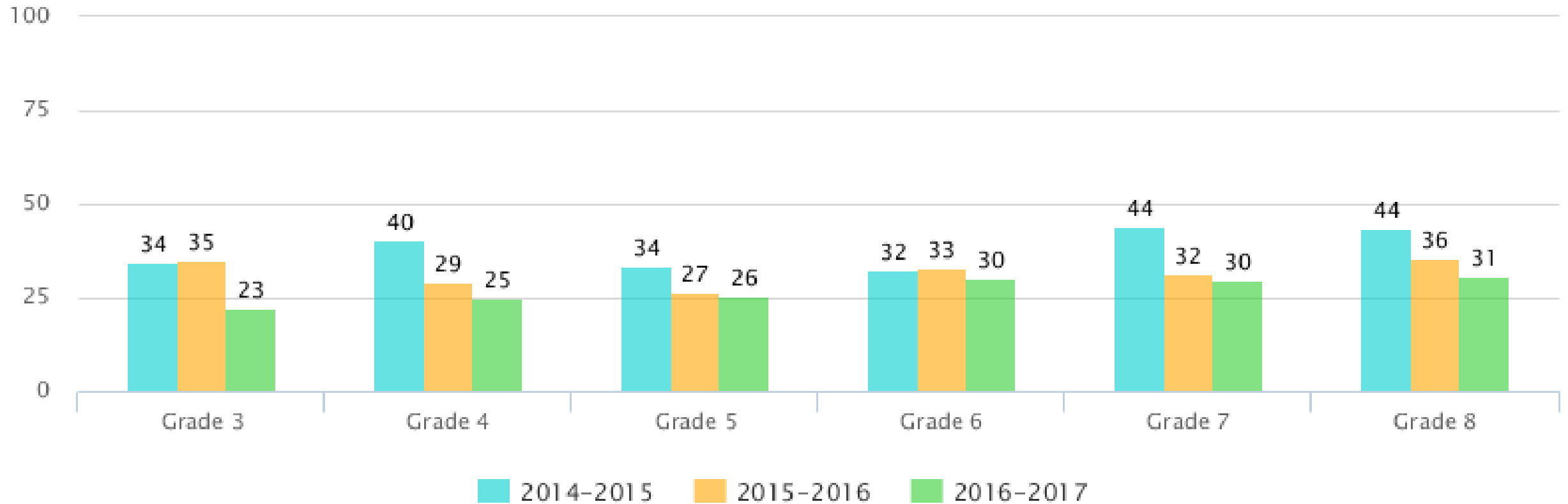

Percent of Students Meeting and Exceeding



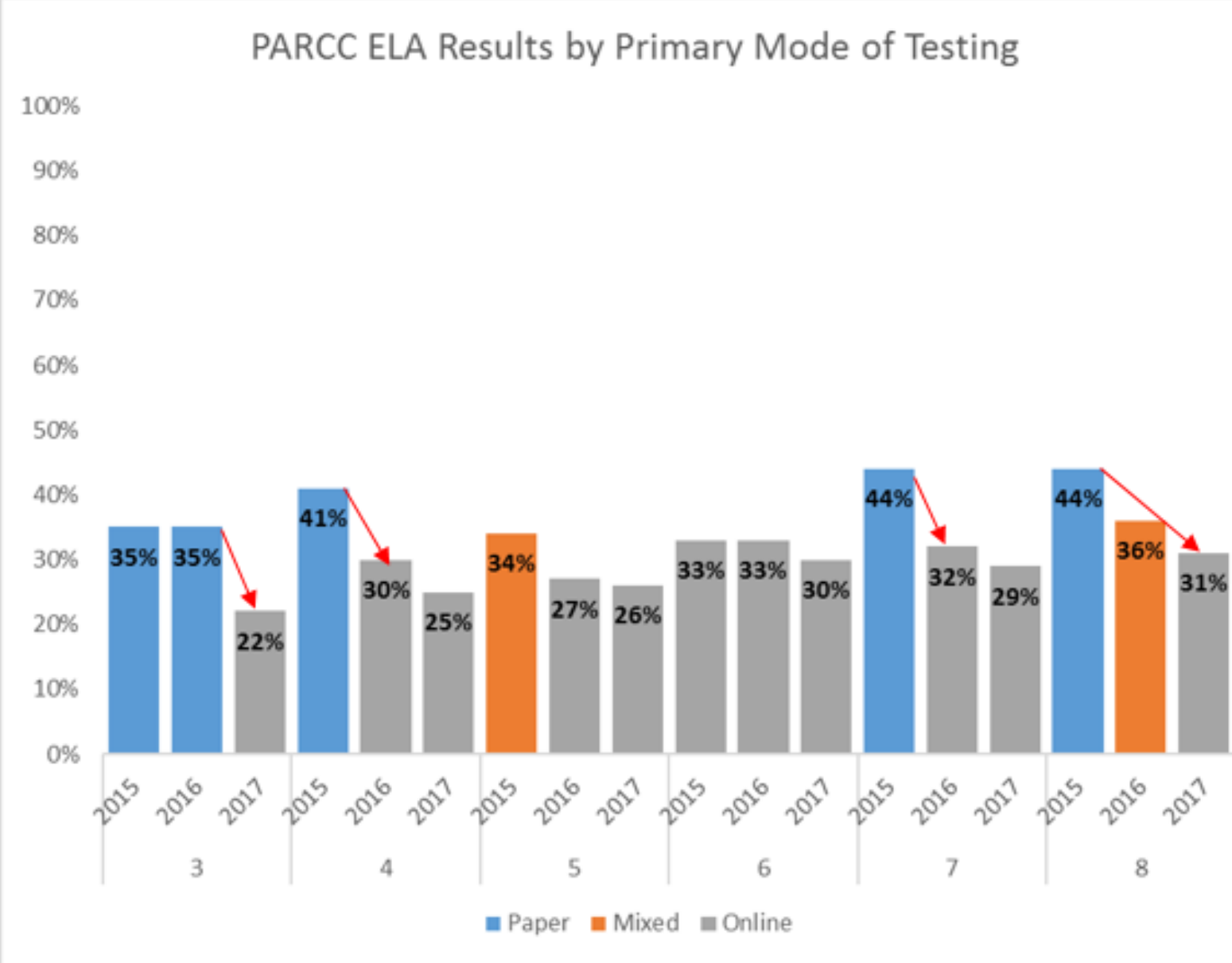
PARCC – English Language Arts Percent of Students Meeting and Exceeding

The decrease in ELA is likely related to the transition from paper to computer-based testing.

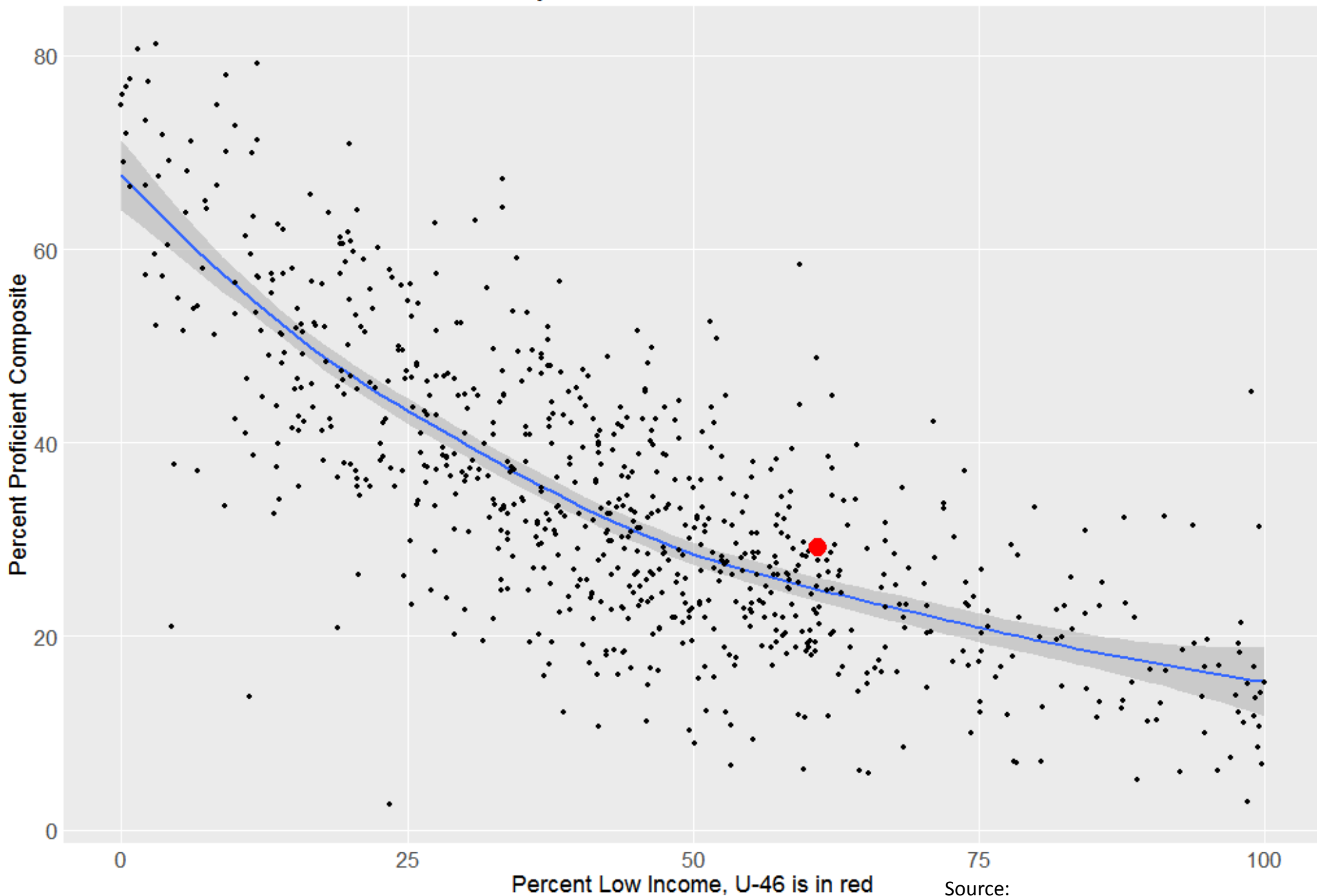

Given a statistically significant relationship between the percent of low income students and percent proficient on PARCC, the labeled schools performed higher than expected.

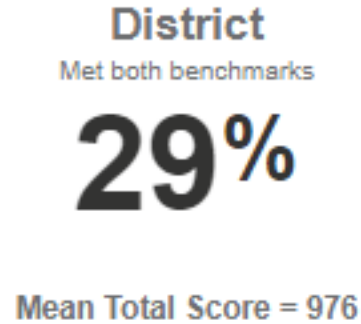

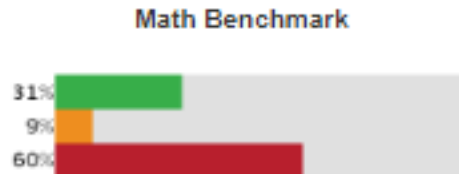
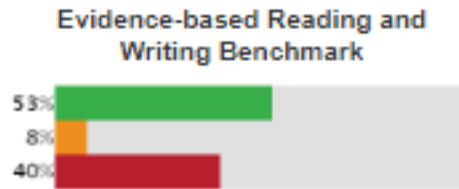
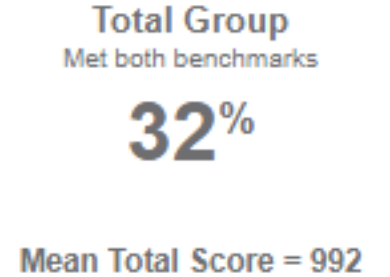
SAT Results

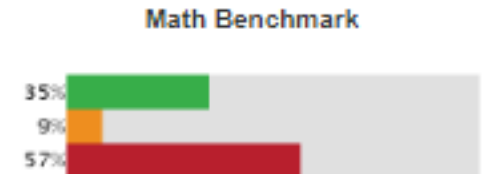
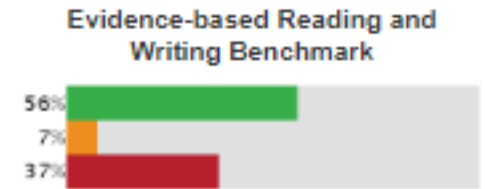
ISBE benchmarks were developed by teachers to align with the Illinois Learning Standards.

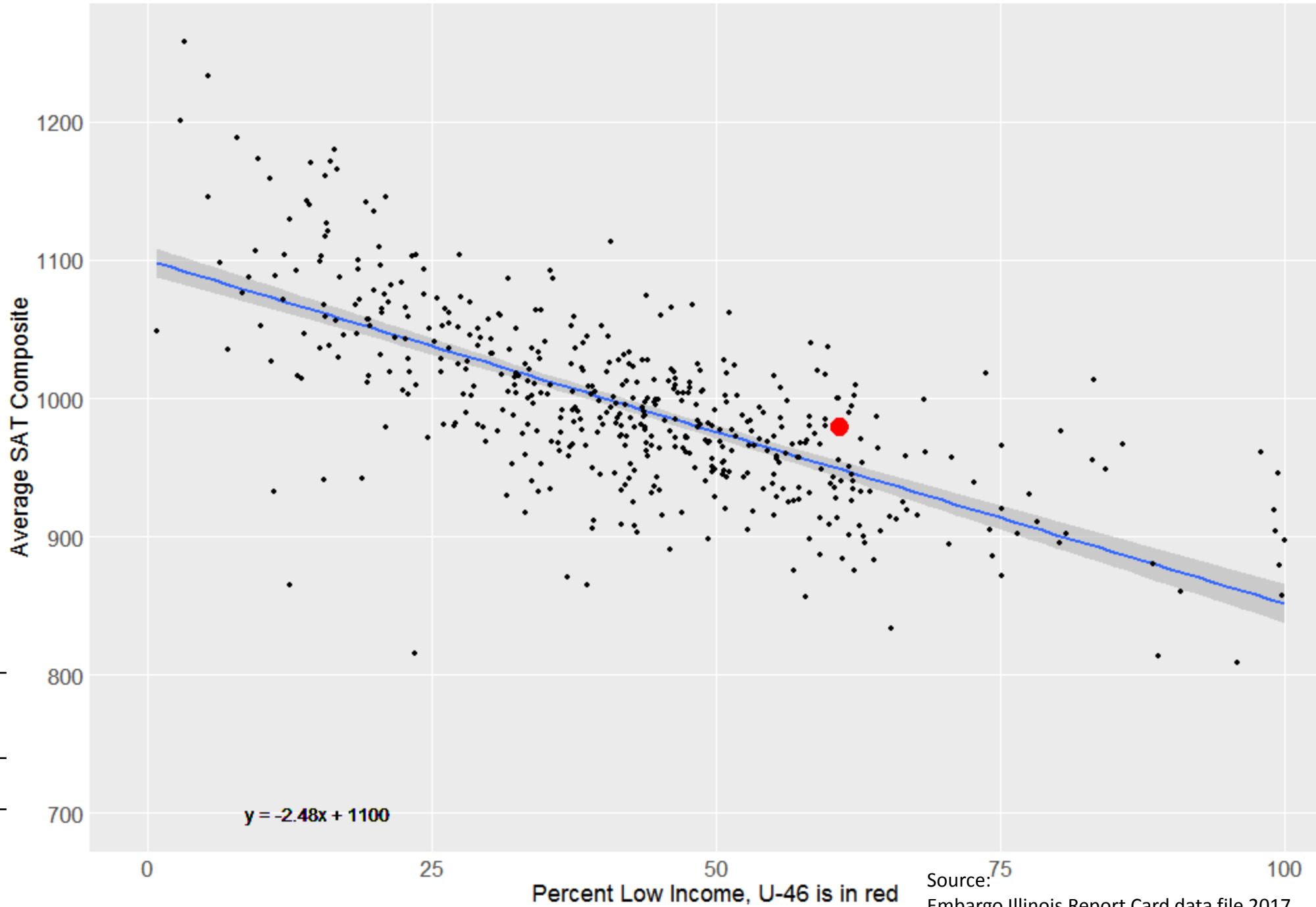

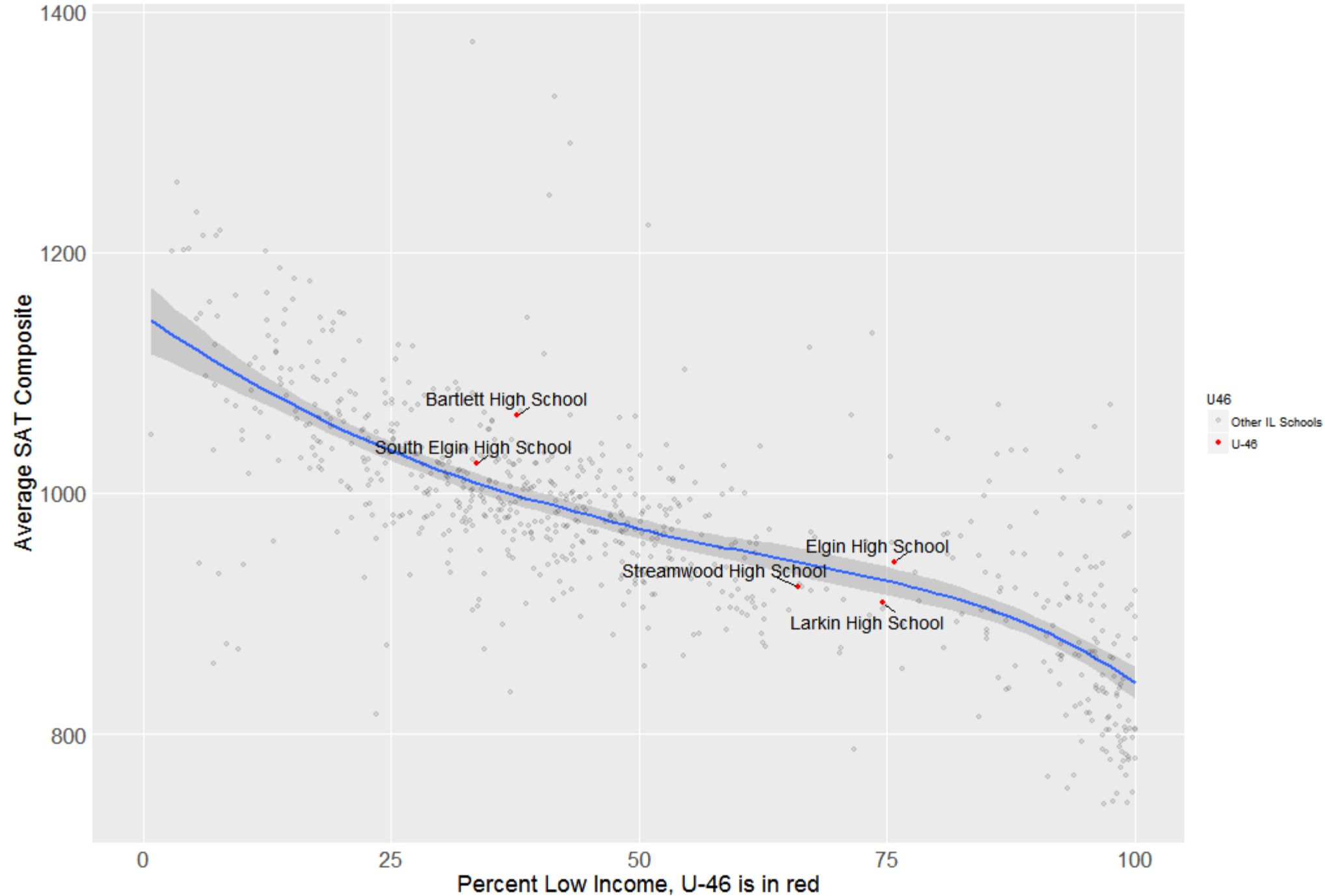
IL Districts Low Income & Average SAT Composite- 2017

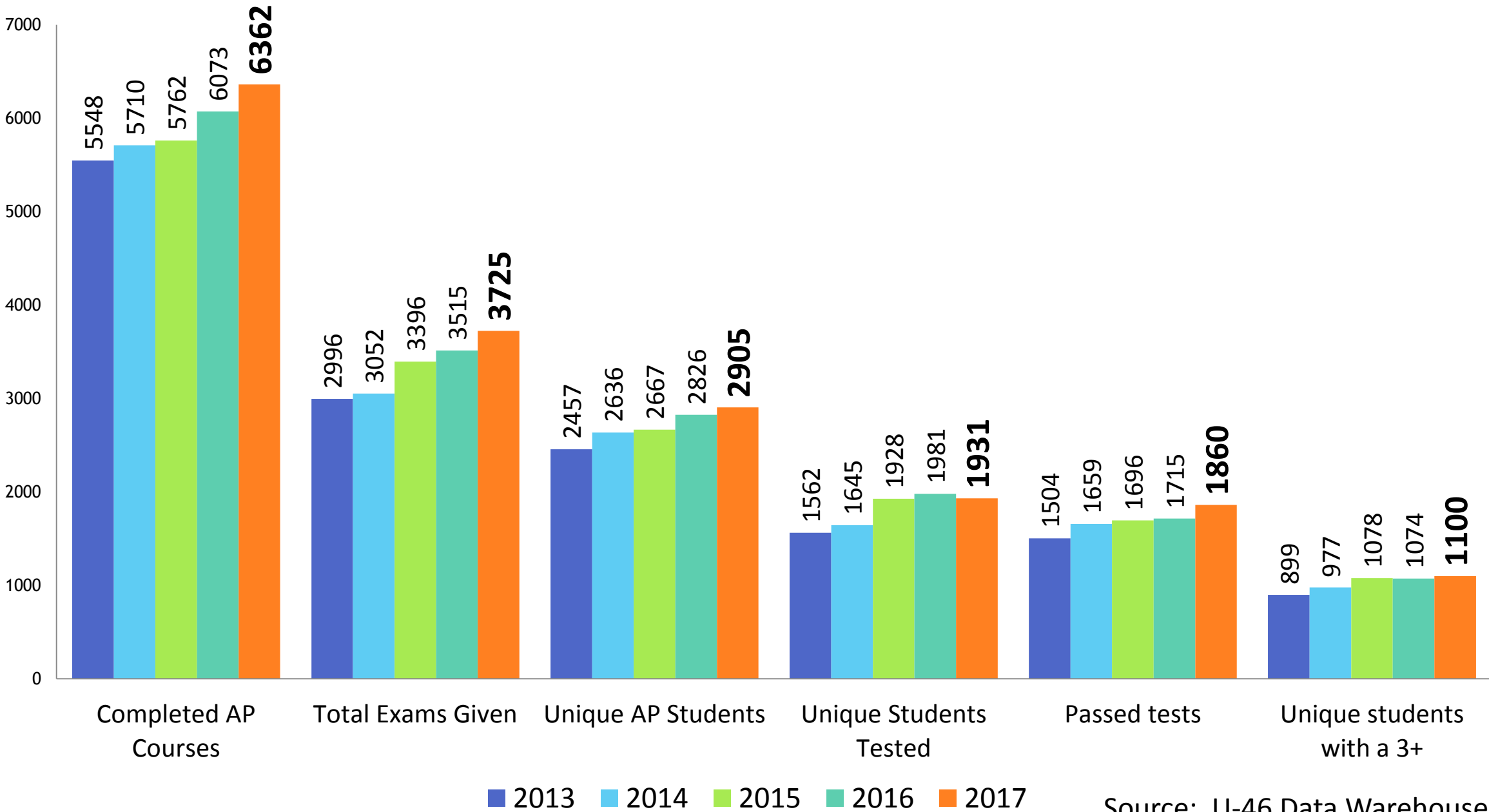
IL Schools Low Income & SAT Composite- 2017

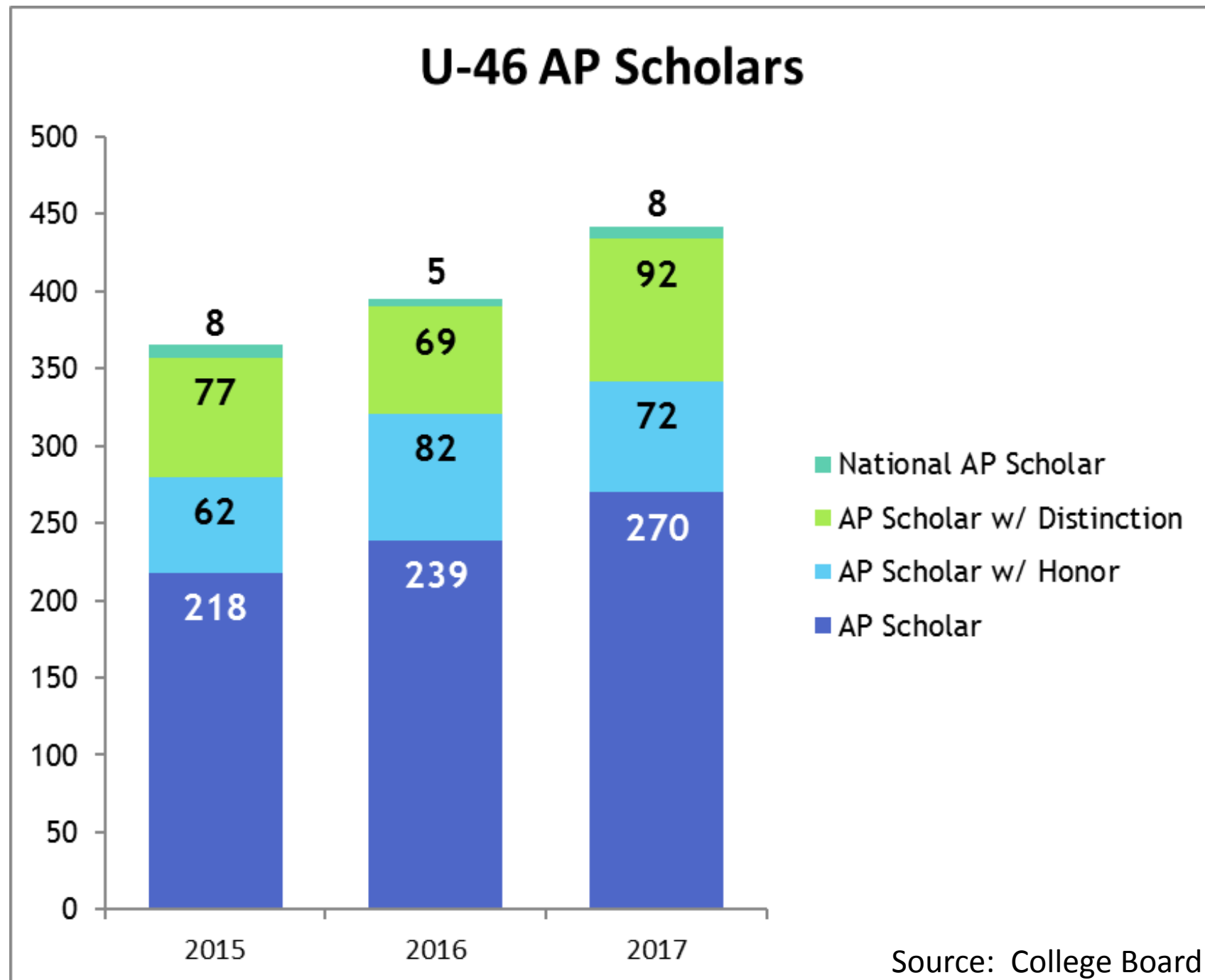

U-46 AP Trend



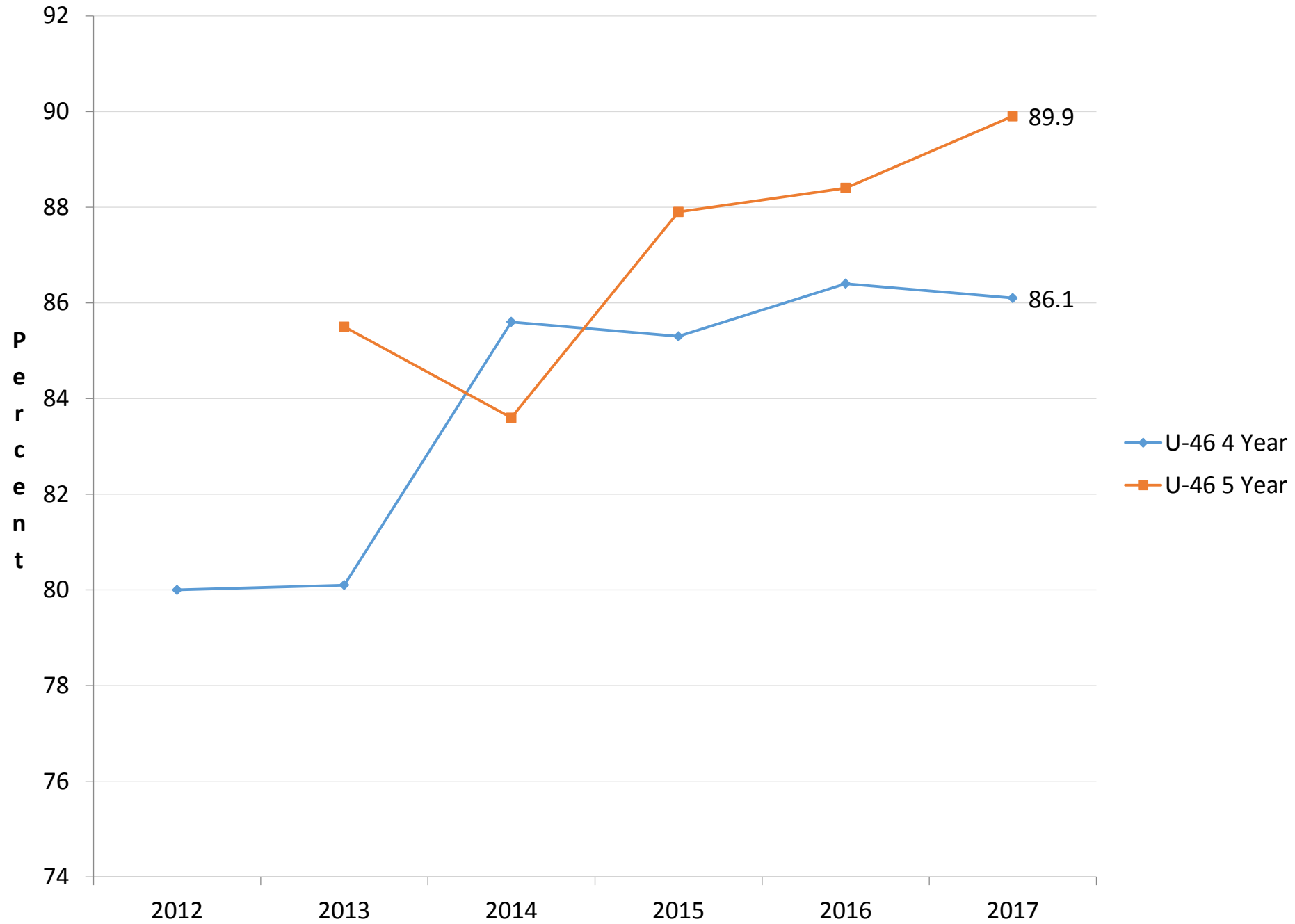

- **AP Scholar:** Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams
- **AP Scholar with Honor:** Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, **and** scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams
- **AP Scholar with Distinction:** Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, **and** scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams
- **National AP Scholar:** Granted to students in the United States who receive an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, **and** scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams



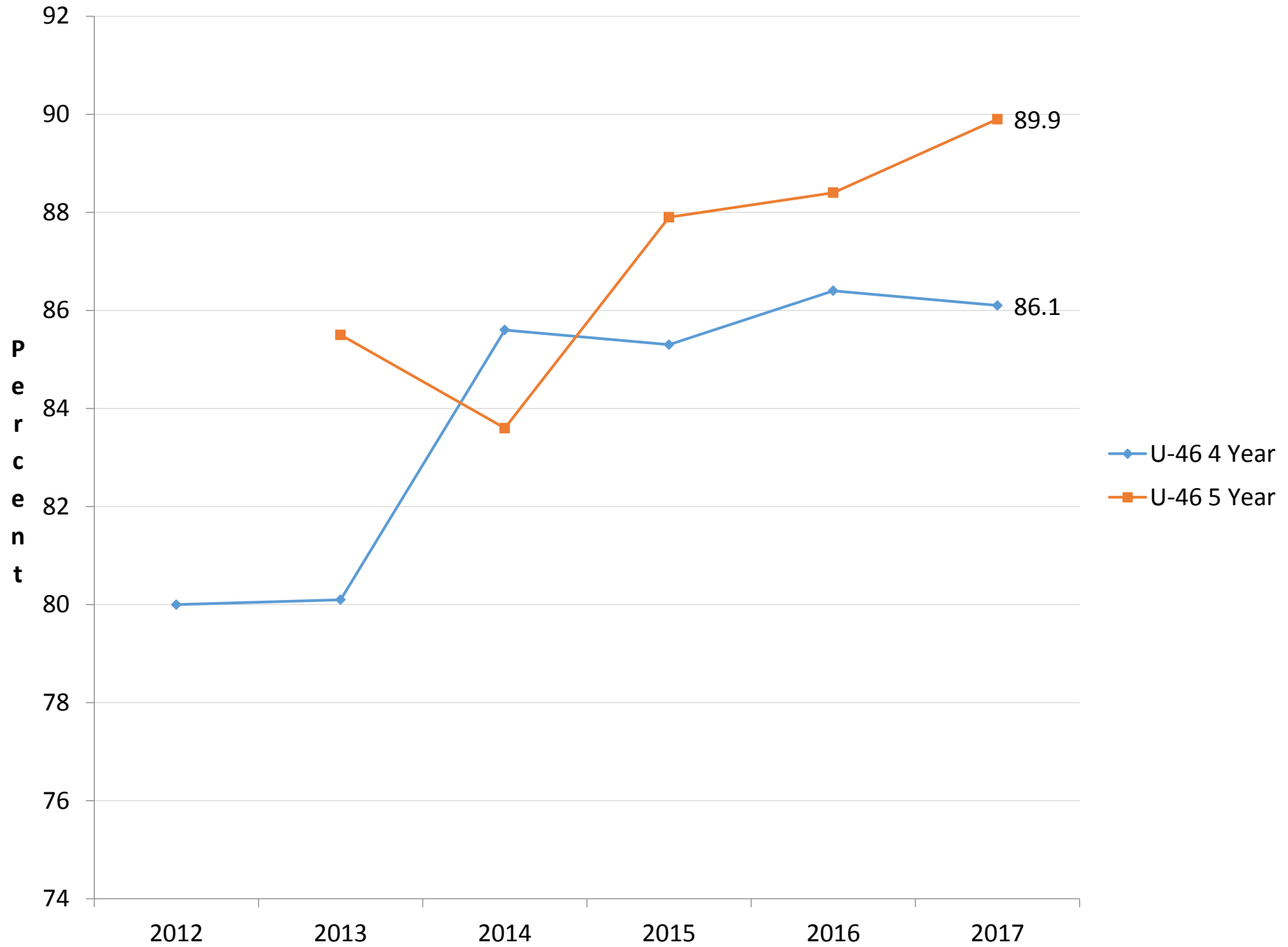
U-46 Graduates

Graduation Rate



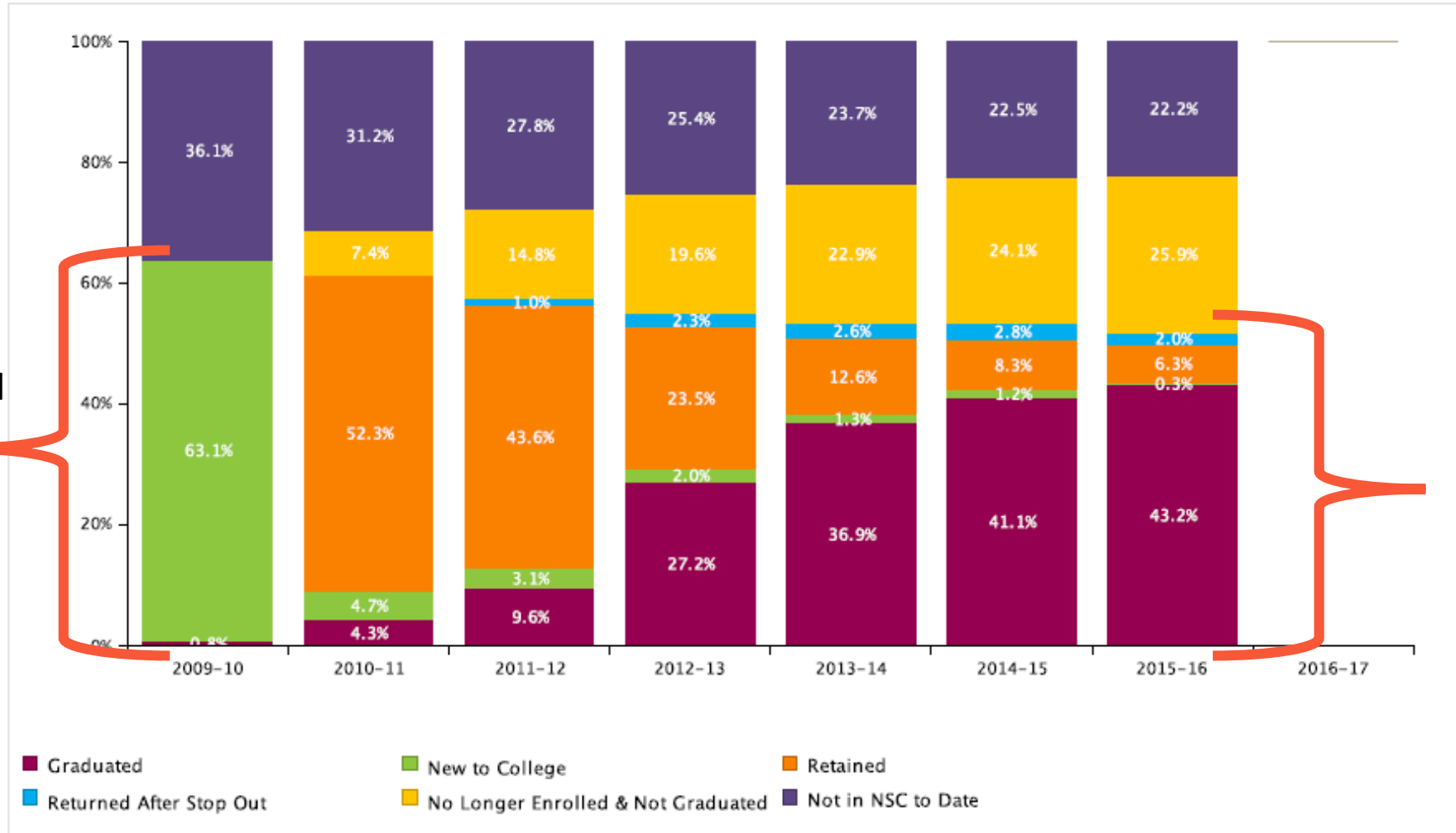

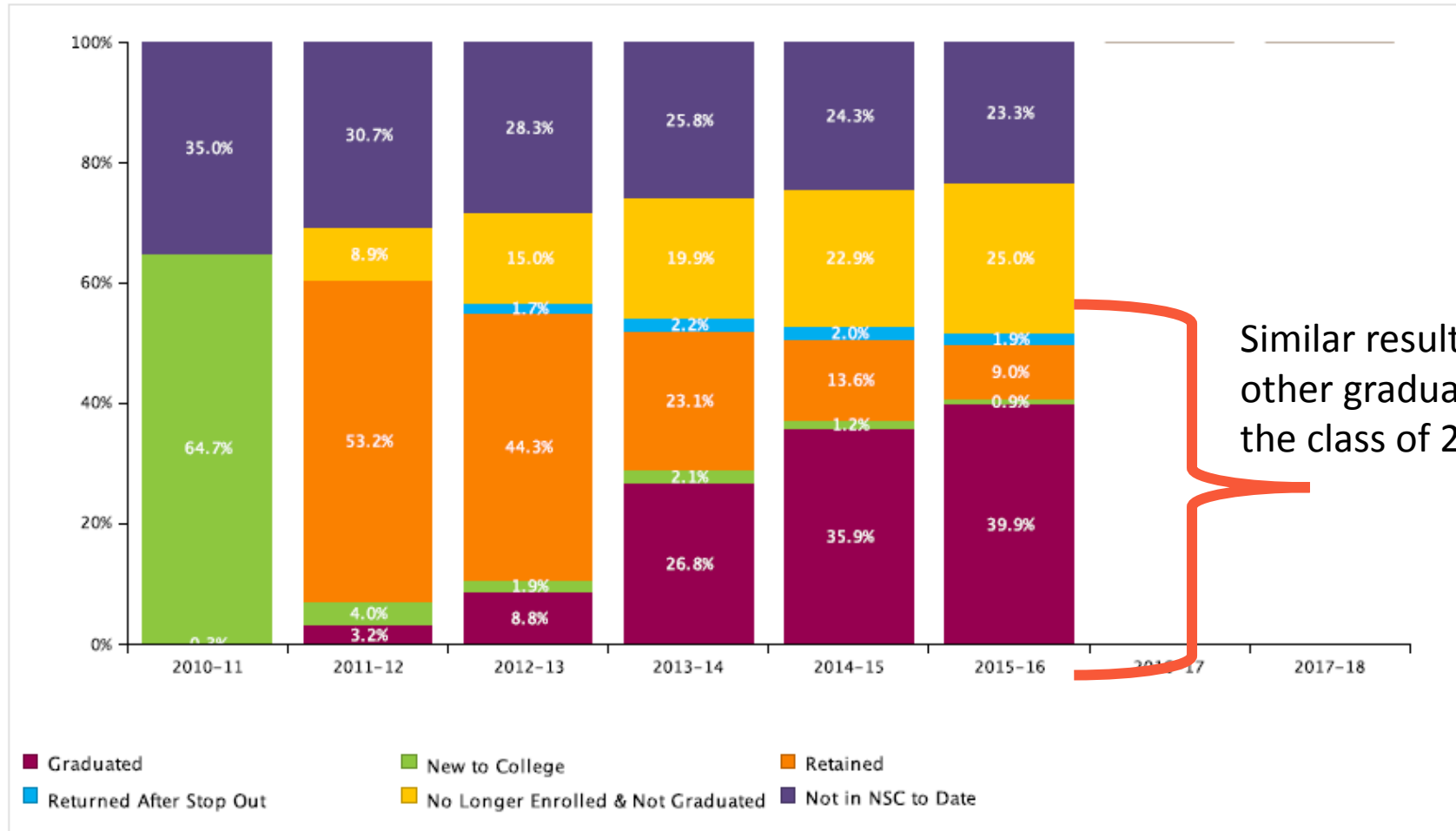
Class of 2009 Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress



63.1% of the graduating class of 2009 enrolled in a post-secondary institution the first year after graduating from U-46.

At least 51.8% of the graduating class of 2009 earned a post-secondary degree or are still enrolled.

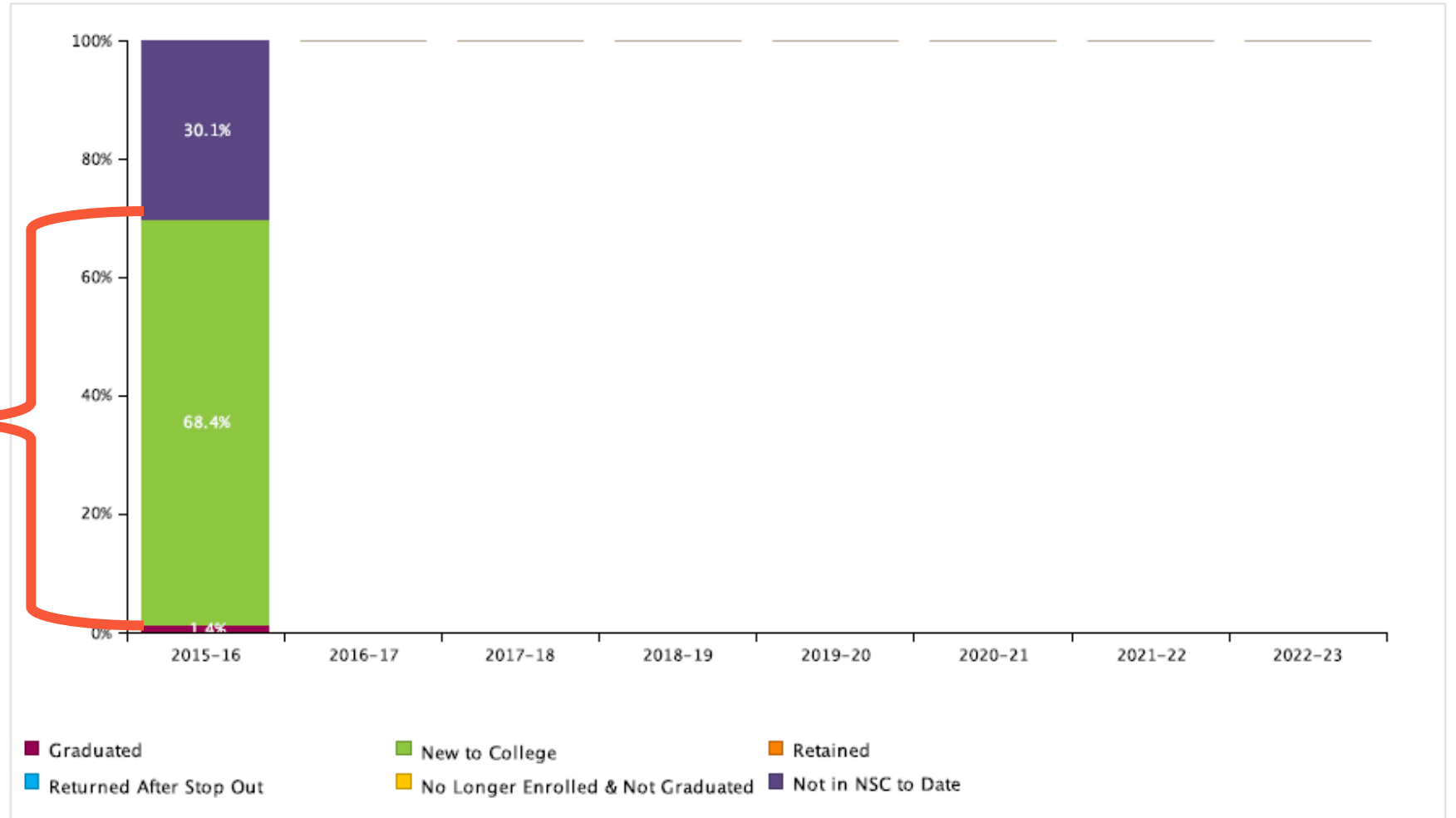
Class of 2010 Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress



Similar results are seen for other graduating classes like the class of 2010 with 51.7%

Class of 2015 Postsecondary Enrollment and Progress

More U-46 students are enrolling in post-secondary institutions directly after graduating compared to previous classes. The class of 2015 had 68.4% of students immediately enroll, compared to class of 2009 with only 63.1%
