Purpose

The purpose is to recommend the adoption of the INCubatoredu™ curriculum and program to replace the Academy Global Business Topics course. This course is part of the World Language and International Studies Magnet Academy located at Streamwood High School.

This academy is in the process of changing themes to The LEAD (Leadership Entrepreneurship Action Design) Academy pending full review and approval. The INCubatoredu™ program will play a key role in the academy's theme transition.

Rationale

- In 2018, the District supported transitioning the pocket academies at each high school to Magnet Academies. The transition is in alignment with the district-wide plan to implement Educational Pathways.
- Streamwood High School's current academy, World Language and International Studies, has been in existence since the late '90's and has experienced declining enrollment and lack of interest.
- Hanover Research conducted a survey open to all U-46 students, parents, staff, and community members in the spring of 2019.
 - Priority skills identified were critical thinking, communication, creativity, innovation, problem solving, and being independent and self-directed learners.
- This information provided the foundation to develop a new academy that incorporates global issues, local issues, while fostering collaboration, critical thinking, and innovation.

Rationale Continued

- The proposed theme of the new Magnet Academy is Leadership, Entrepreneurship, Action, and Design (LEAD).
 - Implementing the theme will include revising courses and developing new curriculum.
- INCubatoredu™ supports students with an authentic entrepreneurial year long experience. Students have the opportunity to create and fully develop their own product or service.
 - INCubatoredu™ is a curriculum that fully supports the theme and skills identified as important and desired for the Streamwood High School Academy.

- It would remain 2 credits and be a Junior course in the Academy.

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The Process

Description of Process

- In the fall of 2018, a team of Streamwood High School academy teachers and administrators met with district level administrators to discuss revisions to the academy.
 - Several themes and ideas including service projects, entrepreneurship, global scholars, and AP Capstone were explored.
- In the fall of 2019, members of the team talked with and in some cases visited schools in other districts implementing courses and programs aligned to the previously mentioned themes and ideas:
 - Global Scholars at Naperville Central and INCubatoredu™ at Barrington High School.
- The team met with representatives from Uncharted Learning and teachers in the Uncharted Learning network and determined quantitatively, the INCubatoredu™ resource would best support the Academy Global Business Topics course.
- A curriculum writing team was established in November of 2019 through the “Call to Committee” process.
 - The Streamwood High School Magnet Academy Curriculum Team also reviewed the INCubatoredu™ course and determined it was best to replace the Academy Global Business Topics course.
 - The INCubatoredu™ program will play a key role in the academy’s theme transition.

Implementation and Facilities Timeline

Phase 1: 2021-2022

- Pending approval, course would run fall of 2021
- Initial resources and equipment would be purchased using Perkins and CTE funds.

Phase 2: Align with Streamwood Facilities Plan Schedule Proposed for 2022-2023

- Renovate current academy space to include a board room, and INCubatoredu classroom, and an ideation space. [Classroom Design Guidance](#)
- Utilize all resources, equipment, and furniture purchased in Phase 1 in the renovated rooms
