


Instructional Model Scenarios



Continuum of Flexible Instruction

Distance Learning Fall 2020

- Distance learning for all students through the first quarter (October 22) and/or when we are in substantial risk level
- 2.5 hours of synchronous instruction and 2.5 asynchronous during first quarter
- Students will have the option to remain in fulltime Distance Learning or be a part of the hybrid model starting as early as Oct. 26.
- Students continuing in Distance Learning will continue to follow this model.





Framework for In-Person Learning

Based on Guidance from DuPage County Health Department

Glossary:

Self-contained special education classes and transition classes include Center House, SWEP (Secondary Work Experience Program) and the transition program at South Elgin High

EN: Educational Needs classrooms

ILP: Instructional Learning Program

MLP: Modified Learning Program

CTE = Career and Technical Education

Q2: second quarter. Starts Monday, Oct. 26

DHH: Deaf and Hard of Hearing

CTE: Career and Technical Education

Distance Learning: Remote teaching and learning. Features a minimum of 2.5 hours of "live" synchronous instruction each day as well as teacher-guided assignments and independent work with opportunities for students to check in with their teacher as needed.

Hybrid Model: A combination of Distance Learning and in-person instruction.

- Weekly test positivity >5 but <8%

Hybrid model available beginning in Q2 for:
Self-contained special education (EN, ILP, MLP, DHH)

- Pre-K
- Kindergarten-6th grade, starting with K-2 in late October and later bringing in upper grades as we establish protocols and success with limited inperson instruction.

Full Distance Learning Program remains available as an option.

Community Transmission

- Alert for one metric, but remained Blue (IDPH defined) at any point in last 4 weeks.
- Weekly overall case numbers increase for two consecutive weeks with >5% to <-10% increase occurring each week.
- Weekly youth case numbers increase for two consecutive weeks with a >5% to <=10% increase occurring each week.
- Weekly test positivity <=5%. Neighboring counties in orange once in last 4 weeks.



Priorities and Facets of All K - 2 Models



- Safety. In-person instruction will occur with all individuals wearing masks throughout the day, maintaining six feet of social distance, and washing hands frequently. Extra hand-washing stations have been installed across the district.
- Instructional Time and Modes. Every student will receive at least 12 ½ hours of synchronous remote online or in-person instruction during the week, and a balance of asynchronous or independent instruction throughout the week. We will strive to achieve parity in education across all models.
- Start of the Day. Begins with 30 minutes of whole group synchronous learning time. On Mondays, this will be online for all models. On Tuesday-Friday mornings, that morning meeting will be conducted either in person at school, or online.
- Attendance. Student attendance is taken once each day, 30 minutes after the start of the day, consistent with our current practice.
- **Lunch.** All schedules include a break for lunch but lunch for students is grab-and-go, not on site. Additional details about breakfast and snacks are forthcoming.
- Monday Schedule. Three hours online synchronous instruction, with breaks, each Monday.
- Standards-Based Learning and Assessments: Following our learning grade level learning standards and assessments with social-emotional lessons embedded as much as possible.

Priorities and Facets of All PreK Models



- Safety. In-person instruction will occur with all individuals wearing masks throughout the day, maintaining six feet of social distance, and washing hands frequently.
- Modes of Learning. During the week, every student will receive a balance of synchronous remote online
 or in-person instruction, and asynchronous or independent instruction.
- Attendance. Attendance is taken daily. A student is considered present when any substantive (synchronous or asynchronous) participation is observed or documented.
- Meals. Breakfast will be available during full-day preschool. Full-day preschool schedules include a break
 for lunch, but lunch is grab-and-go for students, not on site. Snacks will be available for all preschool
 students.
- Monday Schedule. A balance of online synchronous instruction, with breaks, and independent activities each Monday.
- Standards-Based Learning and Assessments: Following our grade level learning standards and assessments with social-emotional lessons embedded as much as possible.

Updated Middle School Distance Learning Schedule - Starting November 4, 2020



- Allows for daily interactions between teachers and students
 - A combination of synchronous and asynchronous learning time that will mirror what in-person instruction would look like
- Continues to provide office hours for small group and individual support
- Continues to provide time for social-emotional learning and relationship building through the middle school meet up period on Wednesdays
- Attendance will be taken 10 minutes after the start of each class period
 - Students will be marked either present or absent at that time.

Small Group Return to Middle School



- Small groups of students will return to middle schools beginning the week of November 9
 - Students with special needs enrolled in self-contained cross categorical classes
 - Students who receive Level 1, 2, and/or 3 English as a Second Language (ESL) services
- Students will attend in-person classes with their teachers in most of the following content areas: Language Arts, English as a Second Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies
- Students will attend their remaining classes via distance learning while in a designated learning lab

Small Group Return to High School



- Small groups of students have already been in session for Driver's Ed Behind the Wheel courses and for Lifeguarding Courses
- Additional small groups of students will return beginning the week of 11/9
 - Students enrolled in fine arts courses that require in-person instruction during 1st semester (orchestra, band, theatre, choir, 3D art, ceramics, sculpture, etc.)
 - Students enrolled in CTE courses that require in-person instruction during 1st semester (media & digital arts, welding, automotive, precision manufacturing)
- Students may attend in-person classes with their teachers in the classes that require in-person instruction <u>once per week.</u> This may occur during the regularly scheduled period, before/after school, or on Saturdays.
- Students may attend their remaining classes via distance learning while in a designated learning lab or they may leave after their designated course
- Schedules will vary by high school and Principals will communicate directly to students and families

DREAM Academy Return to In-Person Instruction



- Students in cooperative programming will be returning to in-person instruction daily starting on November 16, 2020
- Because students in cooperative programming remain in one classroom, most students will be able to to return to daily in-person instruction
- This allows us to provide in-person instruction to students who benefit from this programming
