## Highlights from the March 21, 2022, U-46 Board of Education meeting

The Board of Education meeting was held at 355 East Chicago Street, Elgin.

The Board began the meeting with an <u>Equity Update presentation</u> by Dr. Teresa Lance, Assistant Superintendent of Equity and Innovation; Ms. Lisa Jackson, Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion; and Ms. Olivia Hollingsworth, Cross-Cat Special Education Resource Teacher.

There was one public comment during the meeting in which a parent expressed concerns about the treatment of his child at a middle school. There were no written public comments.
