Served in 2021-2022, the largest number of middle and high school students to date with over 5,600 students from all eight middle schools and the five high schools benefiting from Alignment's services.



Provided services to U-46 based on the \$88,000 contribution in January 2022 at \$15.69 per student.

Raised total funding of \$230,000 with the community contributing 62% of that funding and U-46 the remaining 38%.



Spring Semester 2022 Outcomes


- Hosted a Senior Job Fair for over 700 students. Students offered placements at Bella Terra, Electri-flex, Elgin Sweeper, Sanfilippo and Sons, St. Joseph Hospital, Zurich Insurance, etc.
- Initiated first regional Educator Rising Conference with Northern Illinois
 University (NIU) in May with fall event planned for October 19.
- Placed 52 students in paid summer internship opportunities.
- Concluded the school year serving 5,610 middle and high school students,
 Alignment's largest reach since the partnership began.

Summer Interns Share Experiences

- Students from Bartlett High School, Elgin High School, Larkin High School, South Elgin High School, and Streamwood High School participated in a 60 hour or longer paid experience.
