







24-25 Elementary Shift in Program Model



ESL Integrated Model



- All classrooms at Liberty Elementary will be ESL Integrated Classrooms
- Allows for language models to support English language proficiency growth
- All classes will teach the same curriculum and standards through rigorous sheltered English instruction
- Aligning our practices to surrounding districts (D300, D54, D15, D59, D205, etc.)

Timeline for ESL Integrated Model

- August 2022 Instructional Cabinet Presentation: MMED brought forward a consideration to research the most effective ESL instructional model
- December 2022 Liberty Staff Meeting: MMED discussed with Liberty staff the most effective ESL instructional model
- February 2023 Instructional Cabinet Presentation: MMED presented the proposal on shifting to an ESL Integrated model for Liberty Elementary
- March 2023, Liberty Staff Meeting: MMED presented the proposal to Liberty staff along with ETA Leadership representation
- April 2023, Liberty and MMED: MMED adjusted the timeline of implementation of the integrated ESL model based on Liberty staff feedback to SY24-25 instead of SY23-24 as was originally proposed
- May 2023, Backwards Planning for rollout and support: MMED used an
 implementation plan designed to communicate with the Liberty staff on
 how staff would be supported with professional development from the
 MME department during the school year SY23-24 in order to launch the
 integrated ESL model during the SY24-25 school year
- SY23-24, Implementation of Backwards Planning support: MMED is implementing the support during Liberty Staff meetings
