


Continuous School Improvement Process

U-46 SIP plans continued to be aligned to the School Instructional **Maturity Model**


School Instructional Maturity Model®

Overview of School Support Structures




School Improvement Plan Highlights

Continuous School Improvement Plans are housed in Google Sites:

- Goals are linked to the School Instructional Maturity Model (SIMM)
- 45-day improvement goals
- School Improvement Plan pages include: Background (vision, mission, and theory of action), School Goals, Supporting Resources, Access to Multiple Data Sources, Meeting Minutes, and Agendas

In addition, each Executive Director has a continuous improvement plan with goals for their network.
