- Review third draft of updated RCSD's Shared Decision-Making Committee plan from 2008 (I'll provide copies)
  - Mr. Doore asked everyone in attendance to take a final glance of the final draft of the shared decision-making plan
  - Vote on the plan and send it to the Board of Education for approval at the January 28th meeting.
    - Members took a vote to recommend for BOE adoption
    - All members were in favor to recommend for the BOE adoption
  - After BOE approval, it will be posted on the district website
    - Mr. Doore presented on how to access the Shared Decision-Making Committee Resource on the website

  - Melanie Bloom discussed the end of the school year grad event, and they are planning to put out a survey to students to see if they would be interested in attending on graduation night
  - FFA and Literacy Week will be separated this year
  - FFA week
  - Literacy Week → parent brought up a concern of having a theme day each day and the cost for parents
  - Stacy Merrill introduced the idea of their character education committee and spoke about the two royal assemblies each month that focuses on the character trait of the month, first assembly is introduction of trait of the month, second assembly is royal recognition where teacher nominates student demonstrating trait, students can also earn royal bucks for displaying that character trait of the month, and students can purchase prizes with their royal bucks
  - Holiday extravaganza with raptor system worked well with tables set up- great idea to have staff park at the other end of the building, streaming on YouTube was a success
