Highlights of the December 18, 2023, U-46 Board of Education Meeting

The Board of Education meeting was held at 355 East Chicago Street, Elgin.

There were two presentations during the Strategic Plan Report Portion of the meeting.

The Board received an update on <u>Equity Plan 2.0</u>, which included detailed goals and improvement strategies to increase student achievement, particularly among African-American and Hispanic students and students with IEPs; improving climate; increasing staff diversity; and other measures.

The Board also received a <u>Facilities update</u> with recommendations for elementary schools. The recommendations include retiring Century Oaks, Washington, Lowrie, and Hanover Countryside; rebuilding McKinley and Glenbrook at locations to be determined; closing Illinois Park as an early childhood center and researching the feasibility of opening it as an elementary school; considering additions and/or updates to Highland and Harriet Gifford; and monitoring Parkwood for declining enrollment.

There were no public comments.
