



Retired when new school is ready - replaced with new building

Retired following the 2025-2026 school year



Retired as early childhood center following 2025-2026 school year. Opens as elementary school for 2026-2027

Boundary Guidelines and Criteria Prioritized by the U-46 Community



- Distance and travel times to school
- Consistent feeder patterns
- Proximity to schools and keeping communities together
- Ability of siblings to stay at the same school
- Stability of attendance boundaries
- Avoid changes in two consecutive years



Feeder Patterns to Create Boundaries




- First step is to determine new attendance boundaries for elementary schools.
- Next, attempt to build middle school boundaries by maintaining pure feeder patterns.




Capacity 450 (18 rooms x 25 students/room)

Special program students who go to another school	-20
Students who come to this school for a special program	10
Total Students In School	345
Additional Space	105

Example of Program Placement Impact






Nearly 1/3 of students residing in Canton boundaries attend Tefft for Dual Language.

Example of Program Placement Impact






Canton receives very few students from outside its attendance boundaries.

Example of Program Placement Impact







Nearly ½ of students attending Liberty Elementary reside outside of attendance boundaries to participate in the English as a Second Language (ESL) program.

Managing Transitions

Options for Shift of 6th Grade to Middle School



Option A

■ Postpone the shift until the 2027-2028 school year for all schools.

Option B

Transition 6th grade to middle school over two years.

*

Option C (preferred option)

■ Transition all 6th grade to middle school in 2026-2027 using Abbott and Ellis as transition spaces until the new middle school in Elgin is ready for occupancy.

New U-46 Boundaries Announced in Spring 2025 (Elem, MS, HS)

- New middle school in Bartlett opens with grade 7 only
- Other middle schools continue serving grades 7, 8 under current boundaries
- No changes to elementary or high school boundaries




2026-2027

Attendance Boundary Changes Take Effect

- 6th grade shifts to middle school
- All 8th graders moved to newly assigned schools
- Rohrssen students attend Abbott (6) and Ellis (7, 8)
 - New middle school in Bartlett now serving grades 6, 7, 8
- Ellis, Abbott Middle Schools retired
- Elementary boundary adjustments take effect
 - Illinois Park, Glenbrook, Century Oaks construction
 - Lowrie, Washington, Hanover Countryside Elementary retired
- High school boundary adjustments for BHS, SEHS only
 - All 9th grade students and new high school students to the district will be assigned to schools based on new boundaries by default
 - o 10, 11, 12 graders will stay at their school by default
 - Families in impacted areas will be presented with an option to have their students attend either newly assigned or previously assigned school

HS Boundaries Roll Up for 3 More Years Until Complete

- Each year's 9th grade students and new high school students to the district - will be assigned to high schools based on the new boundaries
- Once four year roll-up has been completed, no grandfathering or sibling exceptions should remain (i.e. no household exceptions would apply to younger siblings)
