### Hobbledehoy

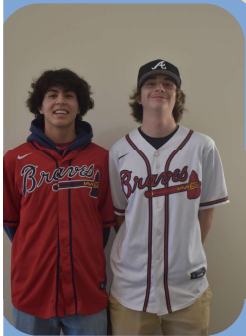
*Noun; A clumsy or awkward youth*
