Follow up questions about funding for camping Michelle said that the fiscal year was reported from SLCSE

In March we have to go to the board because we cannot ask for fees, but we can ask for donations.

Parents are asking to send a survey for camping interest to all families Admin will send a forms out to see the interest in camping to families

Britney Dame is willing to work in a focus group with parents about camping and experiential learning after the survey is sent out.

Michelle is going to look at the spreadsheet with Brittany to understand how much per child

Parents have hesitation about teachers not reacting positively to students who went on camping trips.

Techniques for Tough Times course was discussed

Michelle discussed equity and access for district programming

Geordie asked what the elective classes are available

Geordie has concerns about Math: tracking students to separate math and science. The vision is that students all take the same courses

Review of De-tracking

3rd grade math when they were in 5th grade – never being able to progress year over year and remaining below grade level courses over time

Students were not de-tracked pre-common core

Access and de tracking rolled out through implementation of common core by the states led by the National Governors Association/states ensuring access to grade level content

Michelle talked about core content tracking and unconscious bias pre-common core era/common core era

Geordie questioned "pillars" in relation to tracking
