Campus Grounds External Safety

- Fencing additions across the district
- Safety vestibules at most campuses
- Monitored/controlled access point entry at campuses
 - Access procedures for pick-up, drop-off, lunch & after-school events
- Ballistic film on exterior doors/windows
- External door checks conducted daily
- External door audits conducted weekly

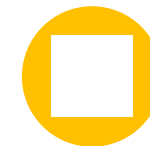

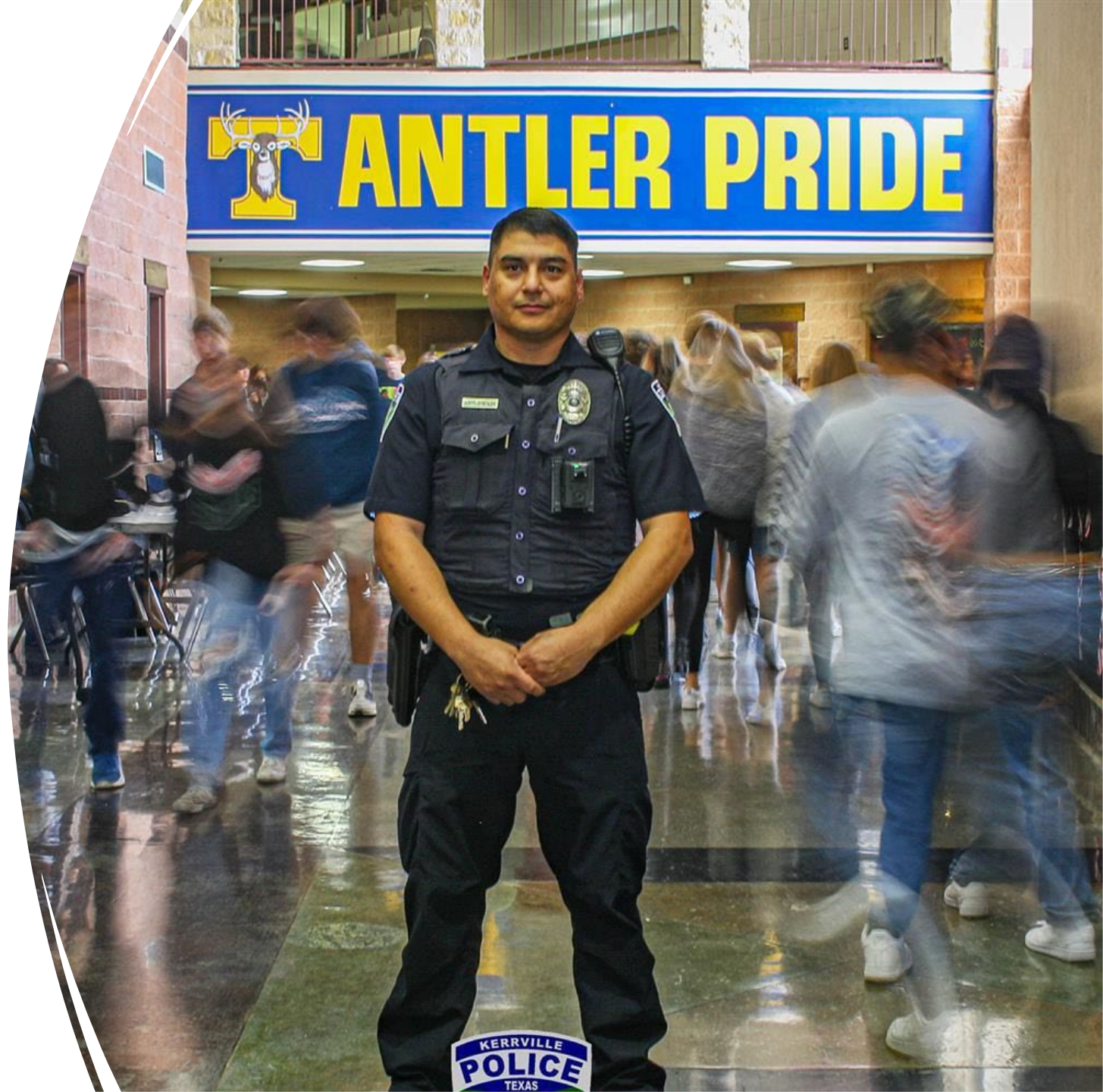

Emergency Preparedness & Drill Requirements

IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Close and lock the door
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

Return to inside of building
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors
Lock outside doors
Increase situational awareness
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door

ADULTS

Recover students from hallway if possible
Lock the classroom door
Turn out the lights
Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door
Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

STUDENTS

Leave stuff behind if required to
If possible, bring your phone
Follow instructions

ADULTS

Lead students to Evacuation location
Account for students and adults
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy.

STUDENTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

Hazard

Tornado
Hazmat
Earthquake
Tsunami

Safety Strategy

Evacuate to shelter area
Seal the room
Drop, cover and hold
Get to high ground

ADULTS

Lead safety strategy
Account for students and adults
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults

HOW TO HANDLE ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATIONS



AVOID

Finding a safe exit is the best option. Students should always have an exit strategy for the buildings they spend the most time in.



DENY

If finding a safe exit is not possible students should then deny entry to anyone seeking to cause harm. If the door does not have a lock, furniture can be used to block the door.



DEFEND

As a last resort, physical defense against the attacker can be used.
