IN OUR CURRICULUM

Spelling: Our next test, on Friday 1/31, will cover List 15 and Rule 19.

Science: In our geology unit, we will enjoy even more edible science! Ask your student what they learned about plate tectonics!

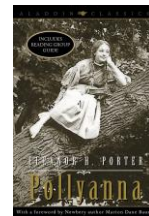
Poetry: Recitations of "Paul Revere's Ride" will take place on Thursday, 1/30. Your student is responsible for memorizing just one stanza of this work.
