



Angel View Outreach offers a full range of Free services and support for families raising children **age 21 and younger** with disabilities. Services include:

**TRIP:** mileage reimbursement for medical appointments

**Mini-grants:** medical equipment, supplies, and services NOT covered by Medi-Cal, CCS, IRC or private insurance

**Activity Scholarships:** to help children with disabilities participate in local programs that allow them to be active, play sports, or participate in the arts

**Resources and Referrals:** help signing up for safety net services, community resources, finding a primary doctor and list of providers for the child's specific disability

**Case Management:** those needing more in-depth services can work with a case manager on an ongoing basis who will help with managing doctor appointments, mental health advocacy, completing forms, budgeting, nutritional guidance, etc.

**Support Groups:** parent support groups, sibling support groups, resources groups, co-parenting groups, and more!

**IEP Advocacy:** translation services with educators/counselors for your child's Individualized Education Program, class evaluation, IEP reviews, support, transportation changes
