Free Youth EKG Heart Screening

Prevent Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) in Sacramento
Youth

One in 300 youth have an undiagnosed heart condition that puts them at risk for SCA

#1 cause of death of student athletes

#1 cause of death on school campuses

23,000 people under 18 are afflicted by SCA annually in the United States

Regular check-ups and sports physicals miss about 85-90% of the issues that can cause SCA in children and young adults. Most conditions must be seen on an electrocardiogram (EKG) because they are structural or electrical issues that cannot be heard through a stethoscope. This is a simple test that records the electrical activity of the heart using small sticky electrode patches that are attached to the skin of the chest. EKG testing is quick and painless. We will also have echocardiogram available onsite upon request from the physicians.

The screening includes cardiac risk assessment, EKG, and doctor review, which takes about 40 minutes.
