Academic Honors Diploma requires **all but one** of the following:

- 4 Math, 4 Soc. St., 4 Sci. (including 2 cr. adv. Science), 1 Fine Arts
- 3 World Lang. (or 2 yrs. of 2 languages), ACT 27 or SAT 1280.
- 3.5 unweighted GPA.

Career-Tech. Honors Diploma requires **all but one** of the following:

- 4 Math - One > Algebra 2, 4 Units of CTE
- 2 World Lang., 3.5 unweighted GPA, IRC Seal or Tech Seal
- ACT 27 or SAT 1280, OMJ or 250 hrs WBL
- Can Replace GPA, Test Scores, or Seals with SSD's
