Tuition Refund Insurance	Tuition Refund Insurance is 2.3% of tuition and covers 50% of pro-rated days not in attendance. If tuition is financed through 10-month payment plan, Tuition Refund Insurance is required.
Books and Workbooks AP Tests	Books and workbooks are included in the CAT Fee. Students (9th - 12th) enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses will be billed for the rental or purchase fees of textbooks used for AP courses and the AP test fees (anticipated at \$100-\$150 per exam).
Chromebook <i>Required for 5th - 12th</i>	Estimated cost ranges from \$400 to \$600. With proper handling and care, devices can be used for up to 6 years. Please complete the 2025-2026 Chromebook Order Form when completing the enrollment/re-enrollment contract. Returning students who already own a Chromebook still must complete a Chromebook Order Form to confirm, elect, or decline the Frederica Academy extended warranty. All new computers purchased will include a 3-year warranty.
Uniforms <i>Required for PK - 12th</i>	Estimated Cost: \$150 - \$350. Uniforms must be purchased through Frederica Academy's approved uniform vendor, Lands' End (landsend.com) or a Parent Association sponsored new and "gently used" uniform sale.
Cafeteria / Lunch	Pre-Kindergarten students may bring their own lunch or choose the weekly catered option from the cafeteria that is delivered to the classroom. For all other students, they may bring their own lunch or cafeteria items can be purchased a la carte via cash or charge to their family account. Average Monthly Cost: \$50 - \$250. KiX After School Care (PK - 6th)	Available until 6:00 p.m. Fees vary according to frequency of use. Visit www.fredericaacademy.org/kix for more information and pricing.
Arts and Athletics (5th - 12th)	Tuition + CAT Fee covers the cost of athletic uniforms, travel, and all cost associated with performances. Other fees may apply, e.g. meals, team photos, spirit packs (attire & consumables), etc.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

Frederica Academy will be offering multiple tuition payment options for the 2025-2026 school year. An additional one-time FACTS Enrollment Fee of \$55.00 will apply on all payment plan options of three (3) months or more. Payable upon selecting your payment plan. Plan options and detail below:

- **Early Bird Option:** Tuition payment in full with enrollment contract by February 25, 2025, with an early bird discount of \$300 (returning families only).
- **Option 1:** Tuition payment in full by May 1, 2025. No additional fees apply.
- **Option 2:** Tuition payable in three equal installments due April 1, May 1, and June 1. \$40 fee per installment.
- **Option 3:** Tuition payable in five equal installments due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, and August 1. \$40 fee per installment.
- **Option 4:** Tuition payable in 10 equal installments due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, August 1, September 1, October 1, November 1, December 1, and January 1. \$40 fee per installment.

Any tuition not paid within 30 days of the selected payment option will accrue interest as outlined under Late Fees.

TUITION DEPOSIT is due with completed enrollment contract by February 25, 2025 (returning families).

This deposit amount is included in the tuition total.

- Once enrolled and a payment option/plan has been chosen tuition payments can be made through the FACTS Family Portal or through the Business Office.
- Frederica Academy allows you to pay using a bank account (checking or savings) or a credit/debit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover).
- The following processing fees apply:
 - Credit Card & Debit Card
 - Payments through FACTS Family Portal – 2.95%
 - Payment through FA Business Office – 3%
 - Checking or Savings account – No fee

CONSUMABLE & TECHNOLOGY (CAT) FEE includes technology and supplies provided in the classroom, books and workbooks (except for AP classes), one-to-one Chromebooks in the classroom in 1st - 4th grades, field trips, Middle School Carpe Vitam* (see 8th grade below), yearbook, student testing (with the exception of AP Exams, ACT, and SAT) and most extracurricular activities. The CAT Fee is billed upon enrollment and due no later than September 15, 2025.

***Not included in CAT Fee (Items will be billed separately to the family account):**

- 8th Grade: \$1,310 additional Carpe Vitam Fee for Washington, D.C. trip to be billed in September.
- 12th Grade: \$400 Graduation Fee to be billed in January (includes full-page Yearbook Ad).

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **Tuition:** Tuition Payments may be made through the FACTS Family Portal or through the Business Office. Visa, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover accepted.
- **Cafeteria & Other Charges:** Payments may be made by Visa, Mastercard, American Express, or Discover. You may maintain a credit card on file for monthly payment of these charges with no credit card convenience fee. Please see the Business Office for completion of Frederica Academy's Credit Card Authorization Form.
- Tuition, Cafeteria & Other Charges can be paid through the Business Office.

LATE FEES

- **Tuition:** If payment is not received within 30 days of the scheduled payment date, per the terms of the enrollment contract, a 3% per month interest fee will be imposed.
- **Cafeteria & Other Charges:** If payment is not received within 30 days of the monthly accounting family statement, a 3% per month interest fee will be imposed.
