Language Arts

"PreK students will acquire language and literacy skills through meaningful interactions with staff and each other. Early childhood is the most critical time for language and literacy development, and the foundational knowledge built during this time is essential to students' later learning."

Students in PreK will...

- Be able to hold a pencil correctly
- Be able to recognize and name all 26 capital letters.
- Learn and start getting to know the sounds of at least 20 letters.
- When a sample is provided, students will try to legibly write all 26 capital letters.
- Students will be able to use scissors correctly and cut on the lines of a simple shape.

Math

"PreK students will be learning basic math concepts. Practicing basics using real world opportunities helps develop their learning. Students will also start building their number sense skills, which are extremely important for their math development" Students in PreK will...

- Recognize and name basic colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, black, gray, brown, white, purple and pink
- Recognize and name basic shapes: circle, oval, square, rectangle, triangle, star and heart
- Count to 20
- Write numbers 1-10
- Match the correct number (1-10) to a set of objects



Science

Students in PreK will use their senses and tools to...

- Learn about the World around us.
 - Learn about plants
 - Learn A LOT about animals- habitats, hibernation migration, nocturnal animals.
 - Do simple science experiments using their senses
