- k. Narrative:**

- I.** One of the primary functions of the RSU #63 School Board is to select a Superintendent of Schools. As determined by the Board, the position of Superintendent may be Interim or Permanent, full-time or part-time.
- II.** To select a Superintendent, a majority vote of all members of the Board shall be required.
- III.** The Board may appoint a Superintendent to a contract of up to, but no more than, five years in accordance with the laws of the state of Maine.
- IV.** The Superintendent is the executive officer of the Board and Chief Administrative Office. In addition, under Maine law, he/she shall serve as secretary ex officio to the Board. He/she shall attend all meetings or, if employed as a Part-time Superintendent, those meetings designated in his/her contract. He/She shall have the right to speak on all subjects, but shall have no vote.
- V.** The Superintendent shall administer and supervise the public educational system of the school unit. He/she shall have discretionary authority, subject to later approval by the Board, to act upon all emergency matters and those as to which his/her power and duties are not specifically set forth or limited.
- VI.** The Superintendent shall devote his/her entire contracted working time to the duties of the position. He/She may, without violation of the provisions of this section, perform educational functions outside the school unit with the approval of the Commissioner of Education and the Board.
