- I.** The evaluation of academic programs will be a major responsibility of the Superintendent, Director of Curriculum, and assigned staff.
- II.** The RSU #63 Board of Directors (the Board) will receive periodic reports from the Superintendent or their assigned staff to enable judgments on the success of the District's academic program.
- III.** All school programs will be under continuous study and evaluation by District staff.
- IV.** The Superintendent will lead the District staff, communities, and Board in the development and on-going review of Board-adopted criteria and standards by which to measure results of the academic programs.
