Awarded to a graduating senior who has been involved in areas of leadership and civic engagement. Application, an essay describing your leadership involvement, and two letters of recommendation - *not from teachers* - are required. Applications can be found in the Guidance office.

Road Forward Scholarship Fund**DUE: April, 8 2025**

This scholarship was established to fulfill the dream of higher education for a local, economically challenged high school senior who is engaged within their community.
