DDD Informational Workshop - 2/26/25

Dear Newmark Parents,

As your teen approaches graduation and adulthood, you may be wondering how to navigate the next steps, especially if they require additional support. After high school, students with disabilities lose eligibility for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), but the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) offers resources to help them transition successfully.

To support our families, Newmark High School will host an informational workshop on navigating the **DDD Service System** for Juniors and Seniors and their parents on Wednesday, February 26, 2025 from 7:00-8:00 PM. The session will cover:

- Steps to determine eligibility
- The importance of applying for Medicaid
- The NJCAT assessment and its role in accessing services
- Making informed decisions
