



Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Enclosed is an application to apply for a Wimberley Community Civic Club (WCCC) scholarship. The WCCC is very pleased to continue this tradition of offering financial aid to students from Wimberley area schools with a record of achievement and who need financial assistance to pursue their educational goals beyond high school. Your application will be considered whether you plan to attend a traditional university or a qualified non-traditional institution of higher learning, such as a culinary school, art institute, or a trade school.

If you are interested and believe you are eligible, please submit the completed application to your guidance counselor (and no one else) by **Wednesday, March 26, 2025**. Applications must be on time and complete or the application will not be considered. In addition to the application, you must also submit the following items:

- A copy of your high school transcript certified by a school official.
- A copy of the first page of your parents' latest income tax return, with social security numbers blacked out.
- Three letters of recommendation, at least two of which are from school personnel.
- A resumé (including the items mentioned on page 2).
- An essay discussing your academic and career vision, and how you plan to use this scholarship. This essay should be a minimum of one page, double-spaced.

Financial need is the most important criterion for award of financial aid, so please be sure to explain why you need the scholarship to achieve your goals.

Awards will be announced on **May 1**. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must comply with two more steps:

- 1) By **August 15, 2025**, you will be required to supply WCCC with proof of enrollment, such as a school ID or class schedule. If you fail to comply with that requirement, you will not receive the money.
- 2) By the end of your first semester, we request a report on how you are doing.

- _____ A copy of the first page of your parents/guardian's latest income tax return, with social security numbers blacked out
- _____ A copy of your transcript

 - _____ Positions of Responsibility/Leadership
 - _____ Honors/Awards
- _____ An essay discussing your academic and career vision. How do you plan to use this scholarship? Where do you see yourself 10 years from now? This essay should be a minimum of one page, double-spaced.
- _____ Three letters of recommendation, at least 2 of which are from school personnel.
