- Students are acclimating to the academics, pressure, stress, time management, study skills while going through stages of adolescence.

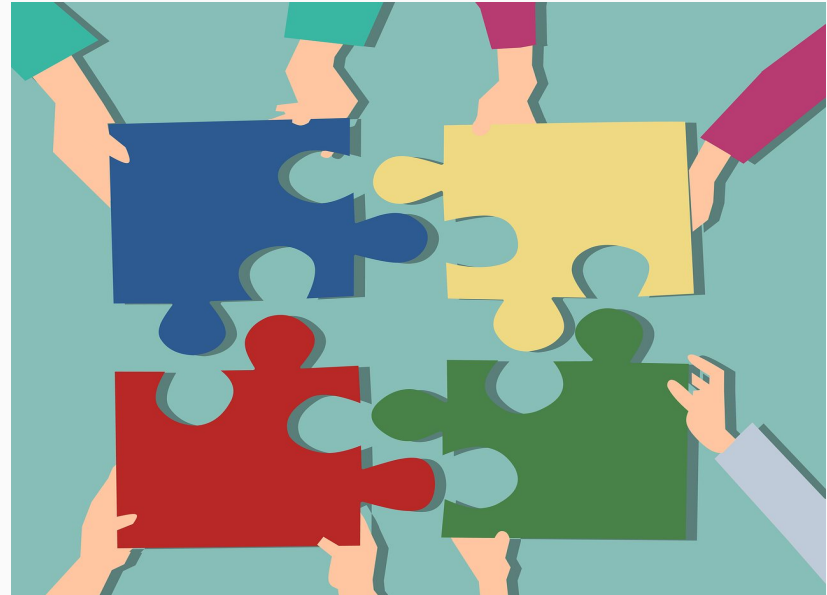
Tips for Students:

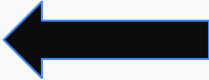
