- Interactive data walk including WRE and FCUSD demographics with data overview and gathering feedback/input. Data presented for student progress.

- Data comes from CA dashboard. Academic performance in ELA (English Language Arts), Mathematics and ELPI (English Learner Progress Indicator).
 - Positive data on English learners growth over the past year. Chronic absenteeism is still present but current attendance rate is 95% which equals the site goal of 95%. Phone calls, attendance challenges and awards are helpful approaches that we are utilizing.

- Title 1 federal funds, Site Supplemental Funds and Supplemental Funding.
 - Title 1 federal funds: Intervention teacher and coach. Support staff for learning recovery.
 - Site Supplemental Fund for staffing. Class size reduction for K/1st and 4th/5th grade. Teacher Sharon agrees with class size reduction. Class size reduction would allow for focused attention and instruction.
 - Teacher for 4th/5th grade class
 - Teacher for K/1st grade class: new proposal due to the class average size being bigger.
 - Restorative specialist
 - Adding hours to BIA for support with translating and speaking with families. Reduction on Paraeducators hours. Parent Alicia commented on the difference between having a Paraeducator and a BIA in class and what happens with a non-bilingual student in class. BIA's offer support to the teacher and all students in class regardless of language they speak with the help of being able to communicate with families outside of the class. Paraeducators offer assistance to the teacher and all the students in the class. Parent Alicia agrees with reducing Paraeducator for more BIA hours. Parent Alicia commented that it would be more helpful to have for students and parents.

- Plans to advocate for more staffing in the process due to a large amount of students being overflowed. Parent Alicia commented on how many students have been overflowed as well as how many new students we have. The number for students that have been overflowed passes more than 30 because of the amount of parents that are still coming in to enroll their students.
- Supplemental Funding
 - Funding for certified subs, subs for Parent Teacher conferences, supplies, technology (replacements), assemblies/field trips, etc.
 - Parent Alicia commented on the 1 assembly we have had and the upcoming field trips.
 - PBIS used for Friday shoutouts and the Pony cart.
