





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GT/Honors Courses

Middle School STANDARD CRITERIA for Honors Core Courses

• 80 or higher average in previously completed core content area

OR

 STAAR content area passed with MEETS grade level. If there is no STAAR score for that content area, student must MEETS grade level performance standards on the most current Reading STAAR

OR

 7th and 8th graders enrolled in AVID elective course or have an Approved Opt-In Form

Students who receive G/T identification in the area of their strength, English, Math, Science, Social Studies or in all four areas. Students are required to successfully meet expectations on STAAR OR make an 80 or above in the course annually to continue GT services in their specific identified area of strength.
