2023 Grade 7-12 Dropout Report

- This report includes data from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023.
- It is a snapshot in time.
- Students who un-enroll for homeschooling are not included.
- Students who dropout during the month they turn nineteen are not included in the dropout count.
- Students listed on an annual dropout report who re-enroll in school after October 1 of that school year remain on the dropout report.

Dropout Rate Calculation

Dropout rates are calculated by dividing the number of students **identified as a dropout** in the current reporting year by the number of students that were enrolled at a school at the beginning of the school year (the October 1 count).

State law (70 O.S. § 35 E) **defines a dropout** as “any student who is under the age of 19 and has not graduated from high school and is not attending any public or private school or is otherwise receiving an education pursuant to law for the full term of the school district in which he/she resides are in session.”

2022 Fall College Remediation Report

- The Remediation Rate Report is compiled by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
- The report is based on public school graduates enrolling in Oklahoma higher education institutions; it does not include data on students from private schools, homeschool, or those attending a higher education outside the state.
- Students scoring a 19 or less on an ACT subject-area test (science, English, math, and/or reading) will enroll in developmental coursework.
- For students taking the SAT instead of the ACT, the subject area scores on the SAT are converted to an ACT equivalent.
- Institutions may offer a placement exam, such as ACCUPLACER, as an additional opportunity to demonstrate content mastery and enroll in a credit-bearing course.
