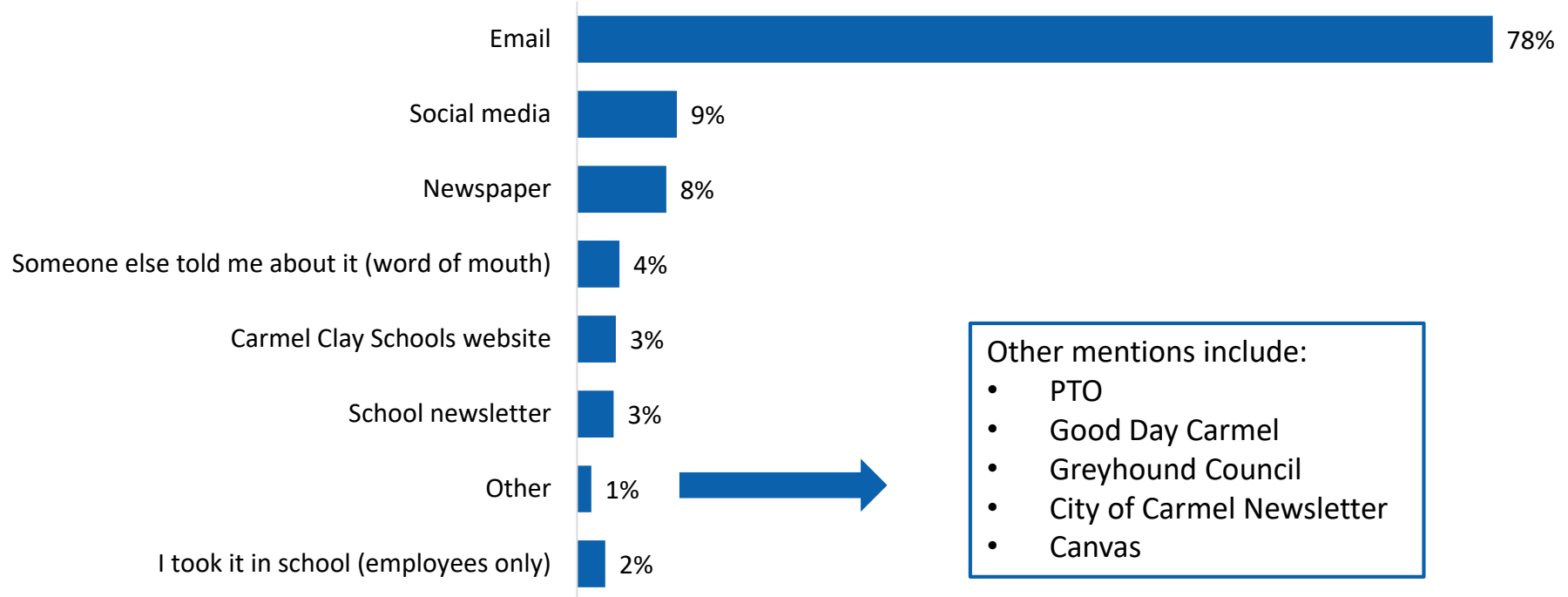

(Select all that apply)

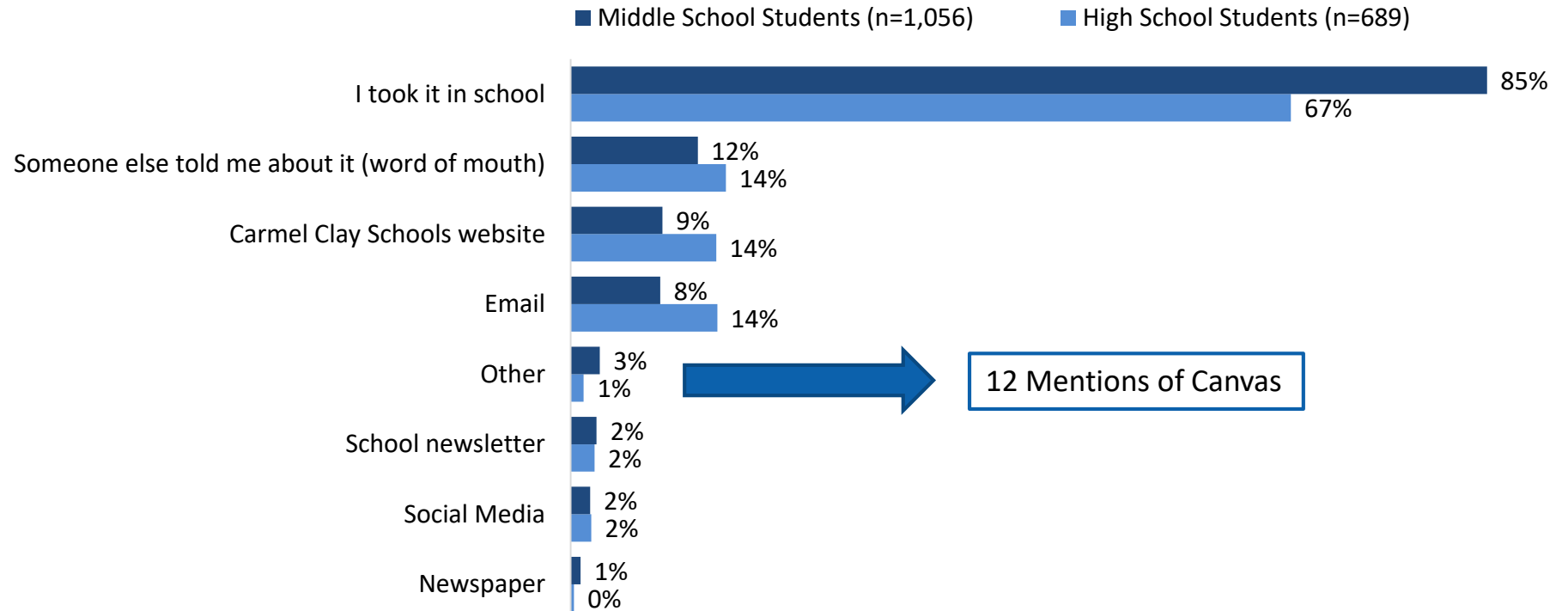

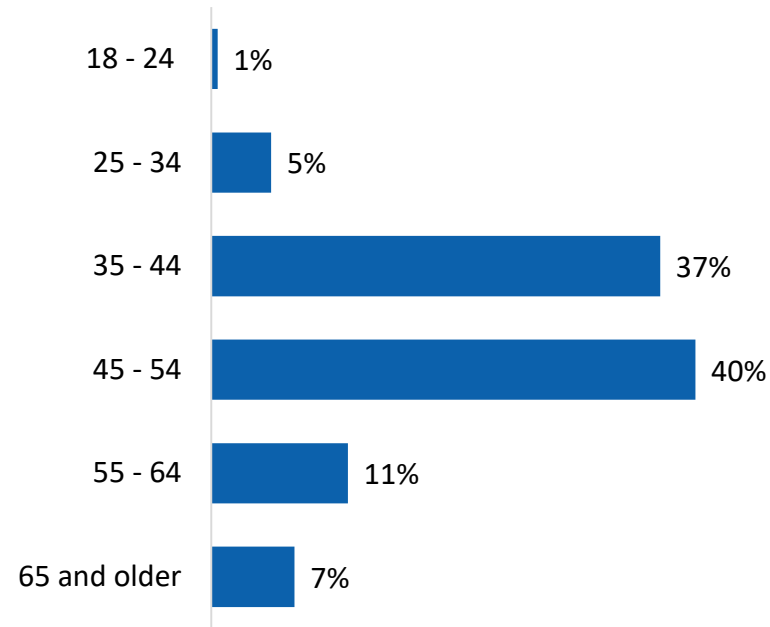
How did you learn about the survey?

Which of the following best describes your age group?

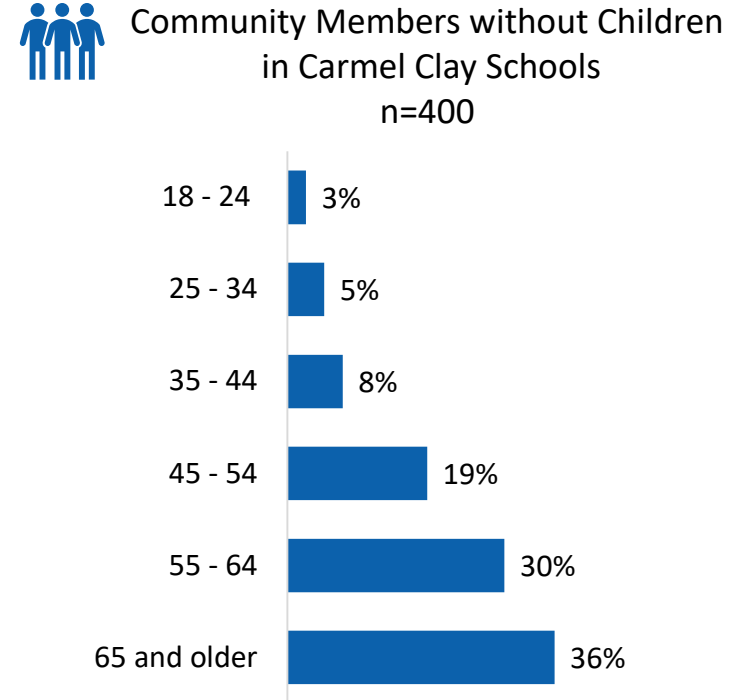
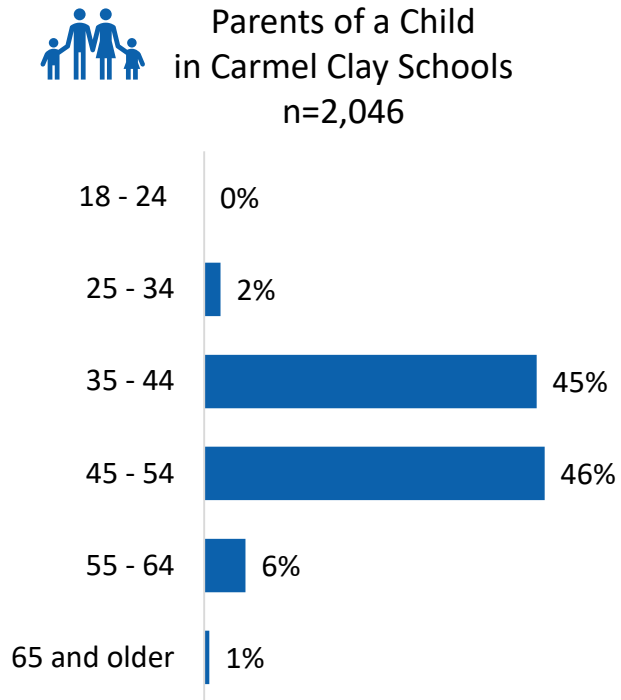

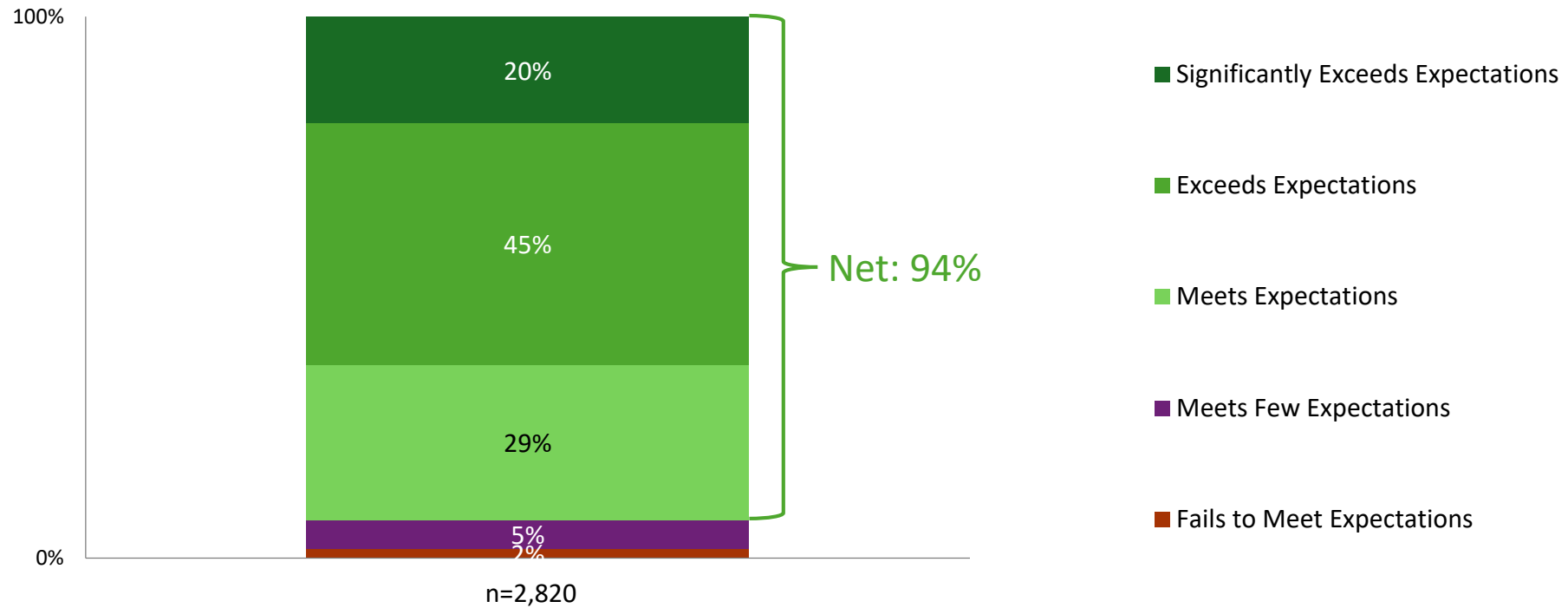
Which of the following best describes your age group?

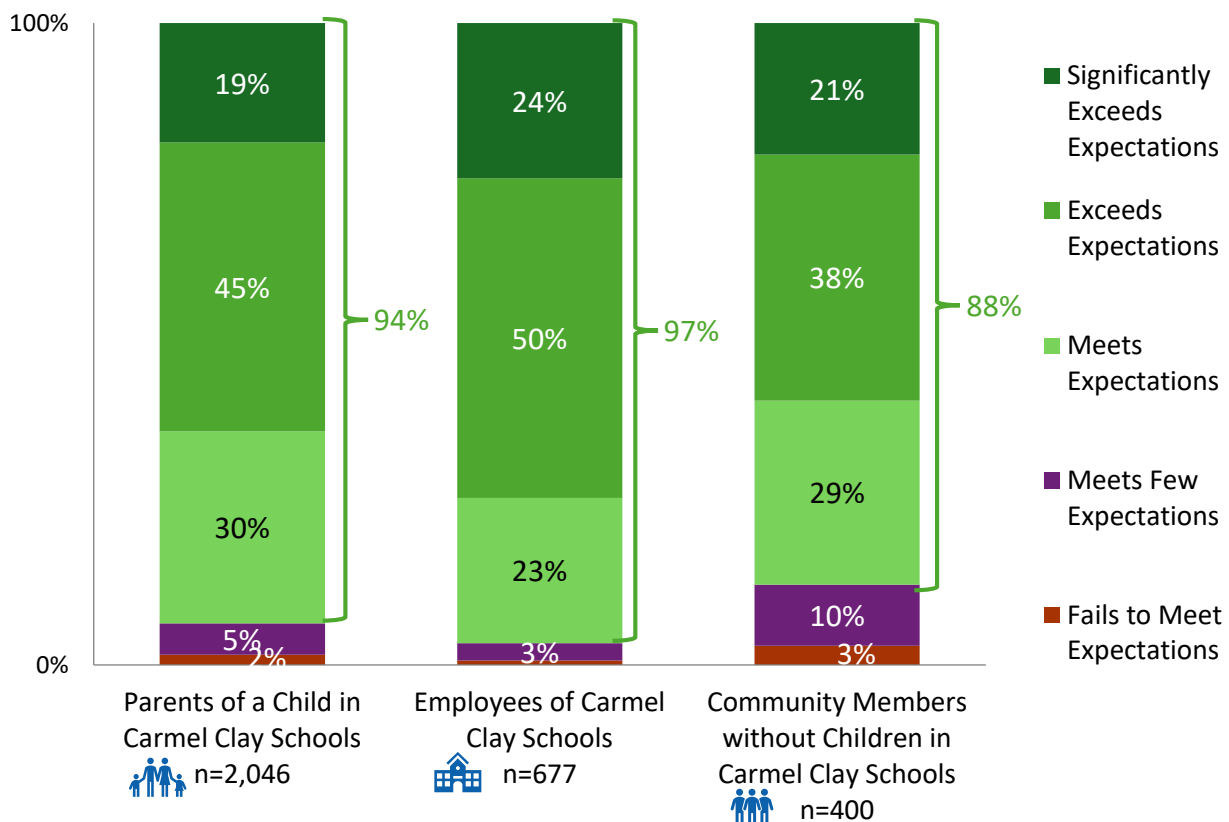
Thinking about Carmel Clay Schools and their overall mission of educating students for the world of tomorrow, how would you describe Carmel Clay Schools' performance?



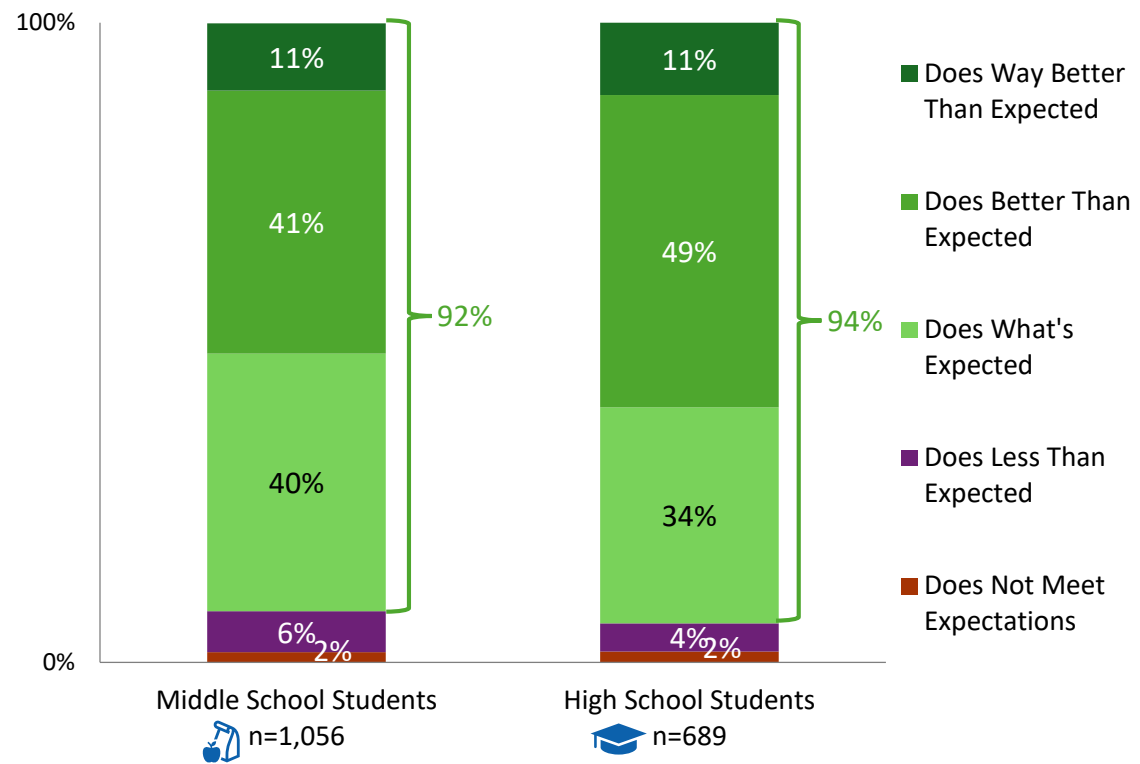
Among all adult respondents, about 2 in 3 indicate Carmel Clay Schools are exceeding/significantly exceeding expectations.

Thinking about Carmel Clay Schools and their overall mission of educating students for the world of tomorrow, how would you describe Carmel Clay Schools' performance?



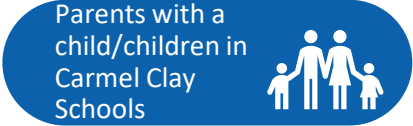
How would you evaluate Carmel Clay Schools for how well they prepare students for the future?



Employees and High School students rate Carmel Clay Schools highest among their respective groups.

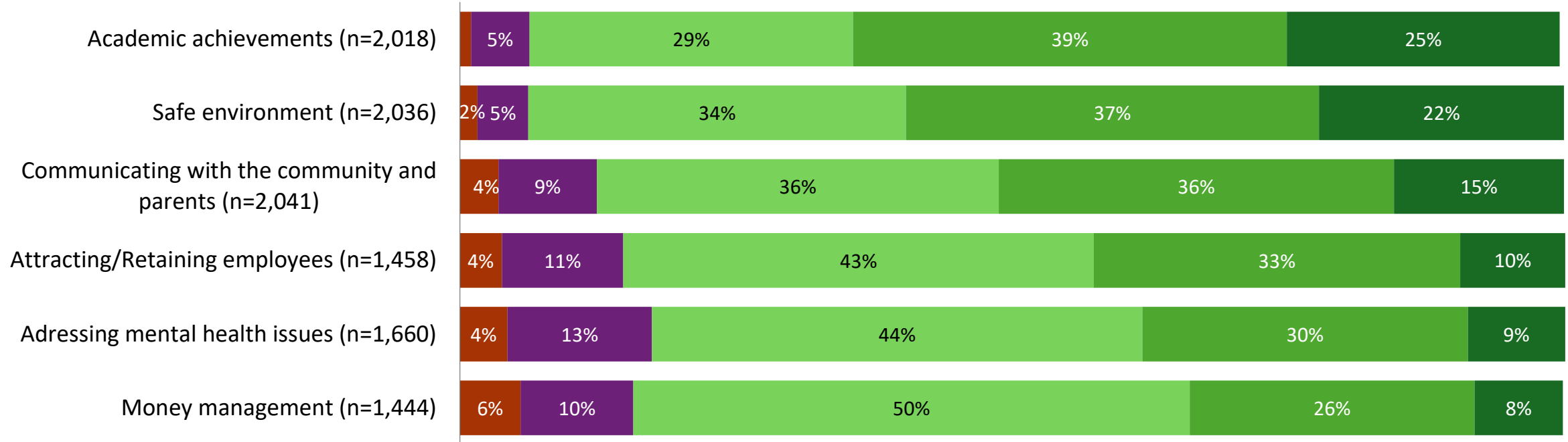

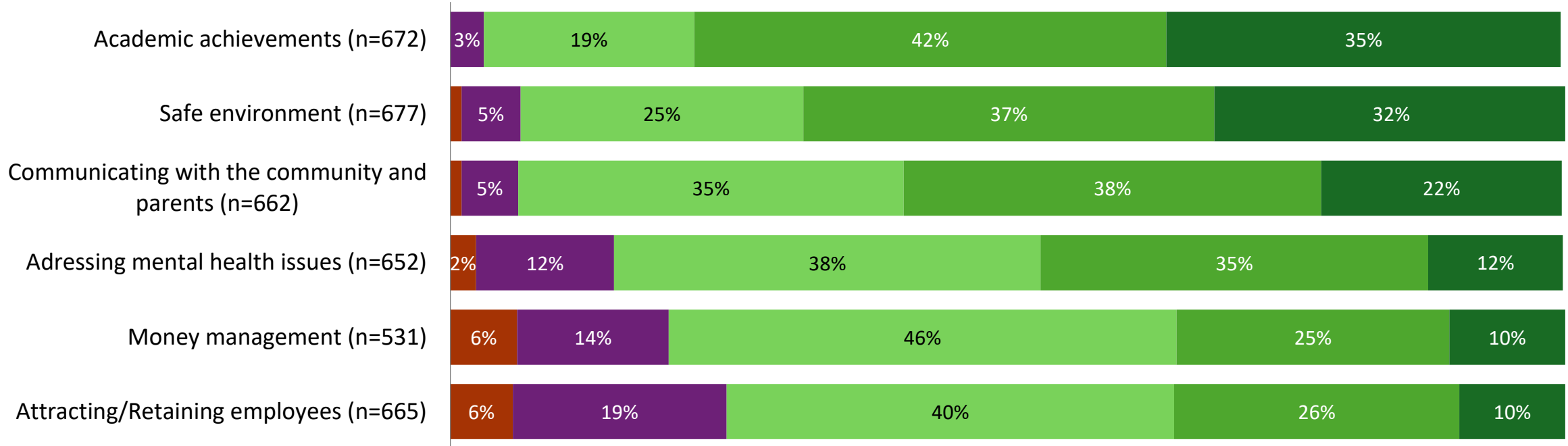

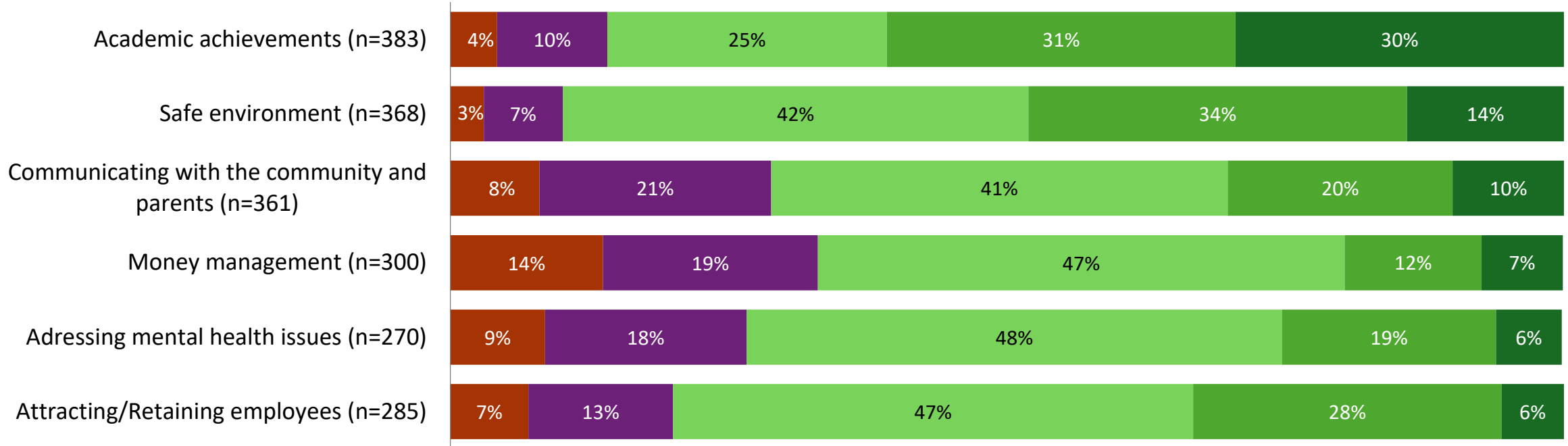

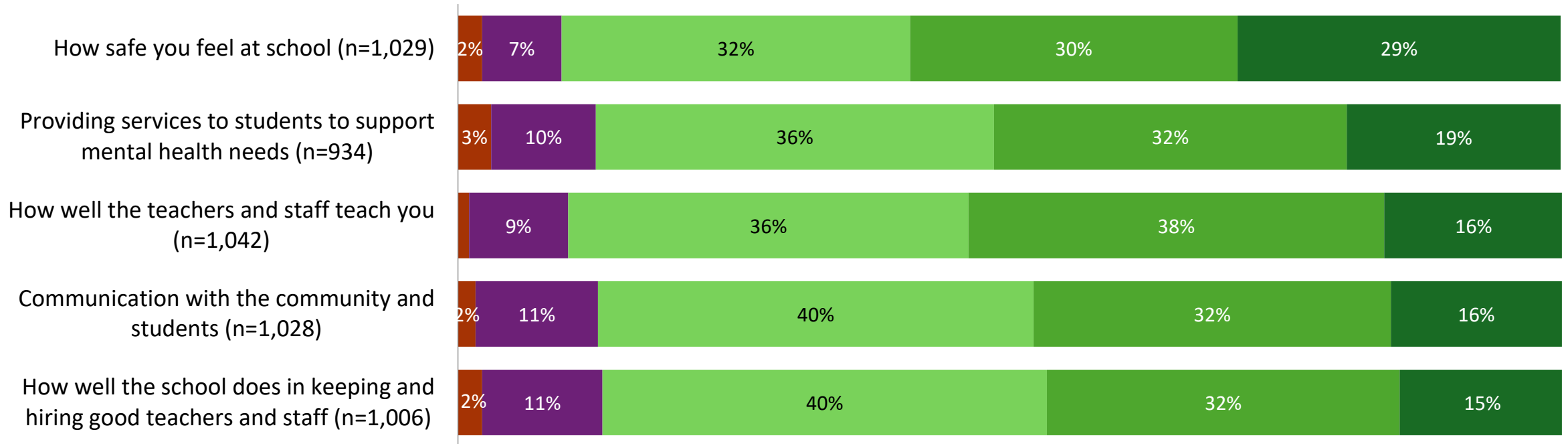
Compared to parents and employees, community members without a student generally rate each item lower—specifically safety.

How would you evaluate your school on these different areas?

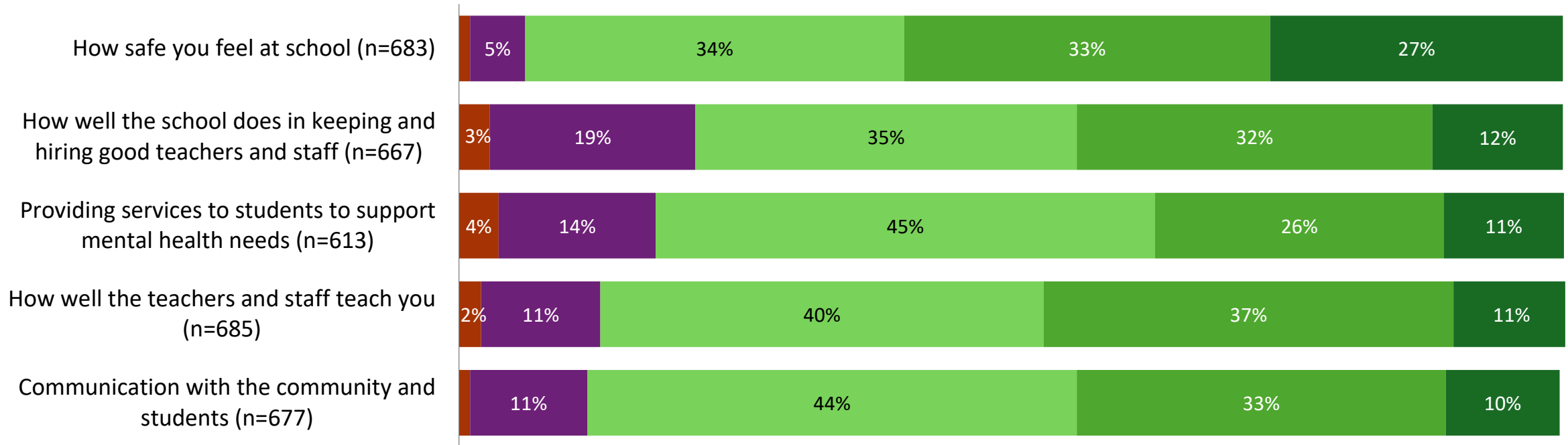

Middle school students rate safety highest among the areas evaluated.

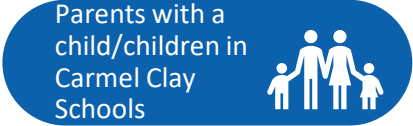

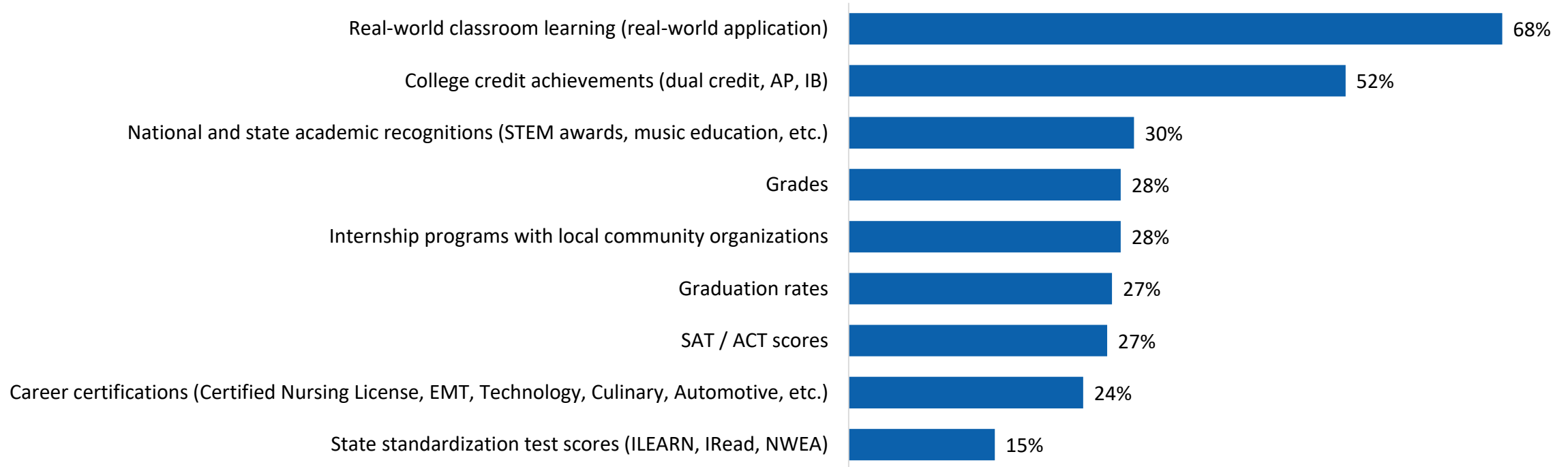

All of the following items below can be considered important for academic excellence. Of these, which of the following are the **top 3** most important to you? (% selected)

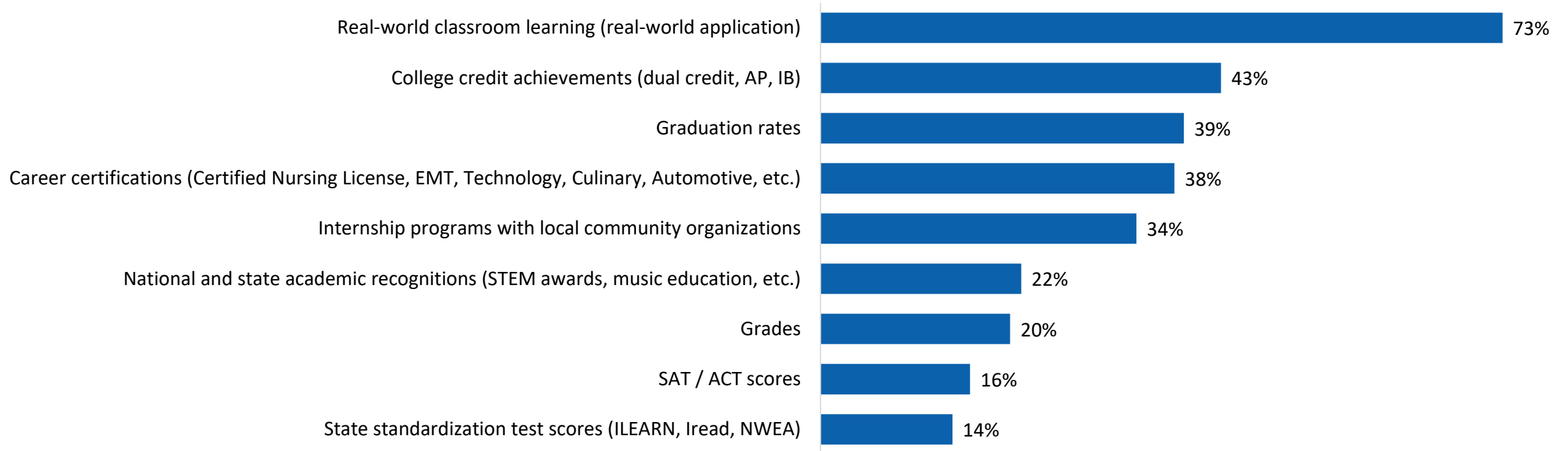

All of the following items below can be considered important for academic excellence. Of these, which of the following are the **top 3** most important to you? (% selected)



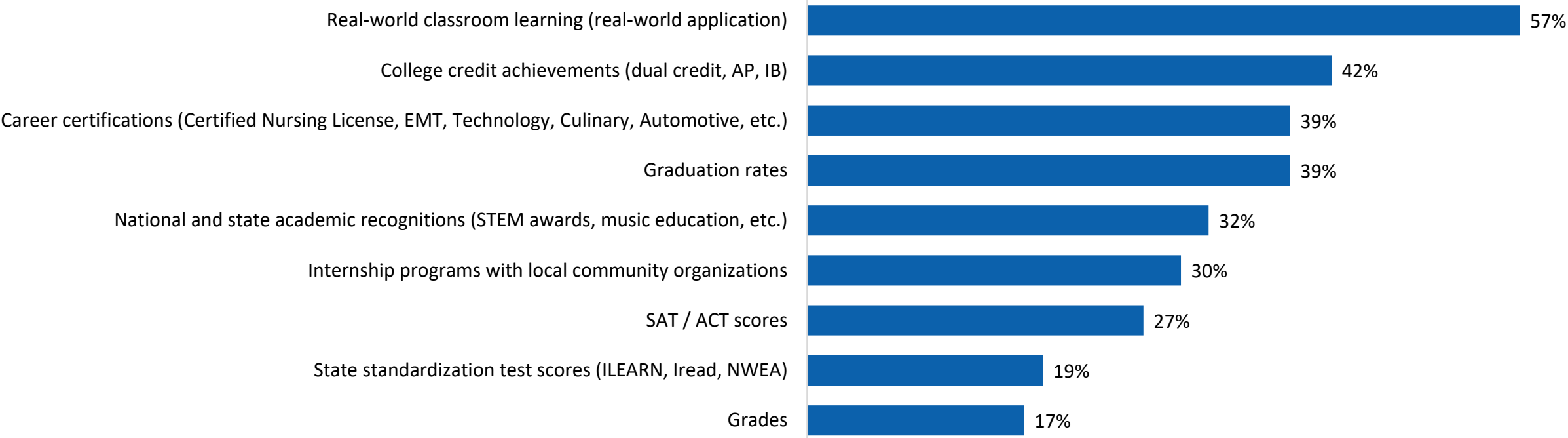

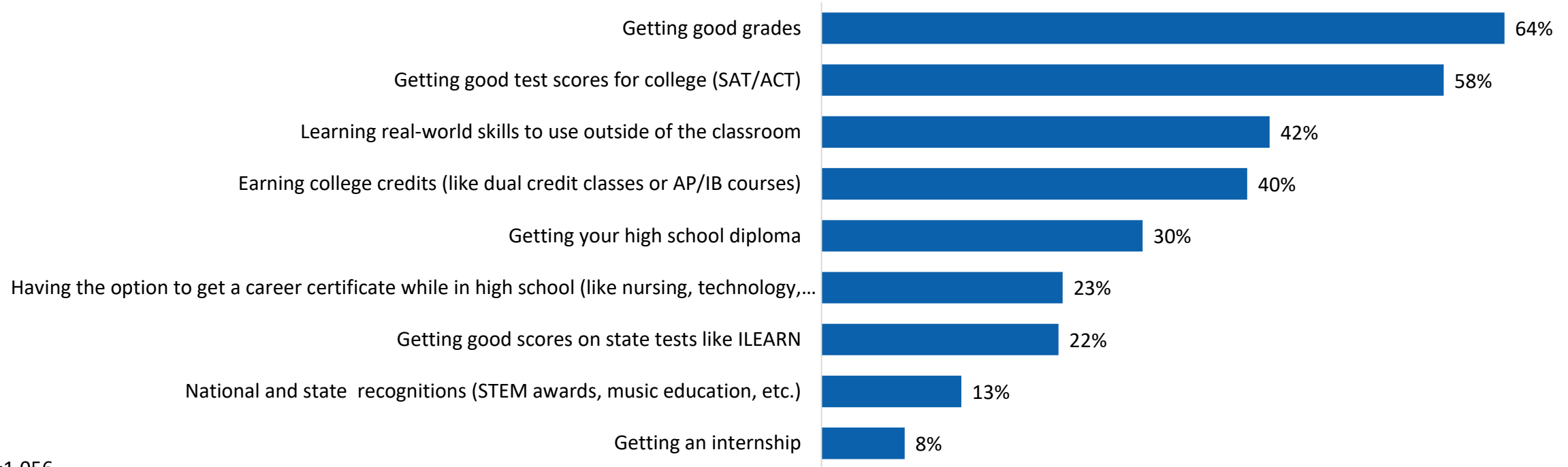
While community members without a student are most likely to select *real-world classroom learning*, it is selected at a lower frequency compared to the other adult groups.

The following items may be considered important for your education. Which are the most important to you as a student. Select the 3 *most important* to you. (% selected)



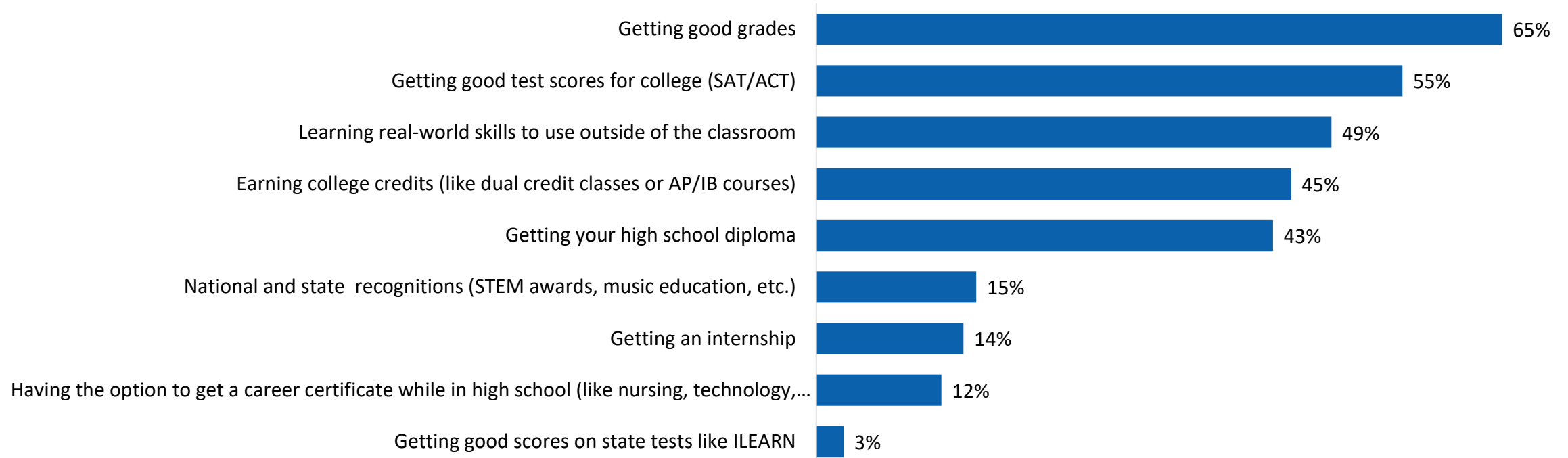

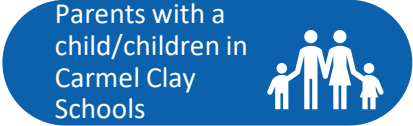

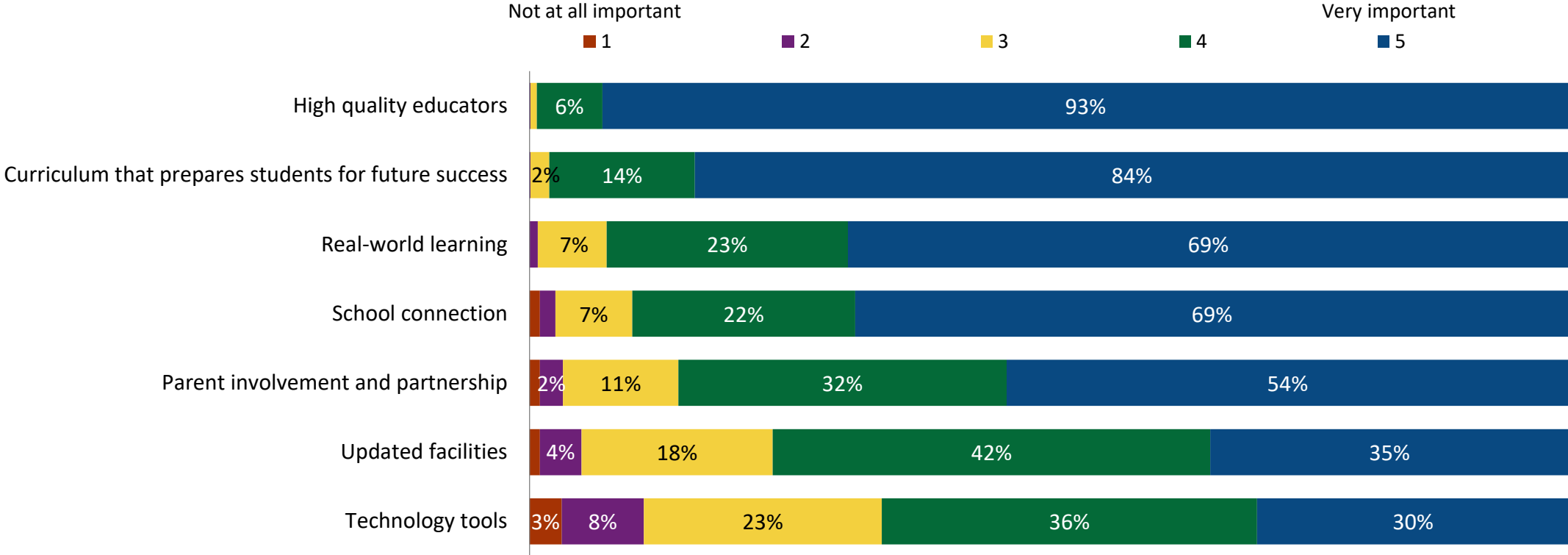

## Importance Rating: Factors Influencing Student Success in Academics



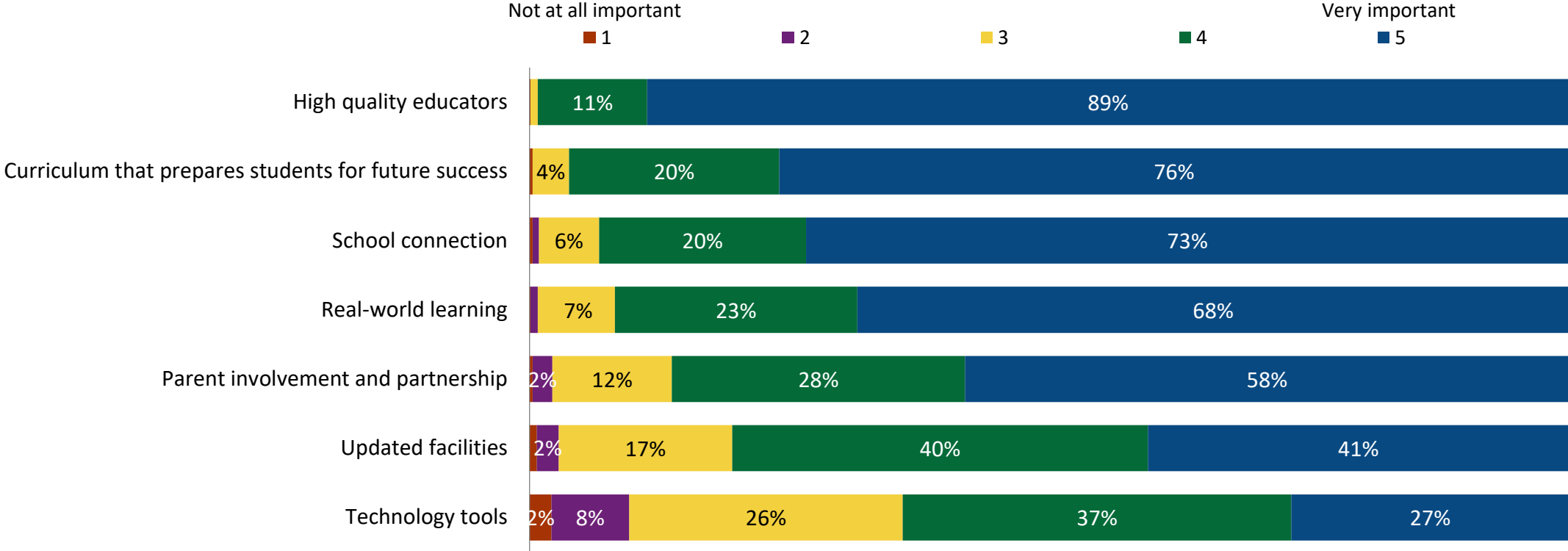

## Importance Rating: Factors Influencing Student Success in Academics



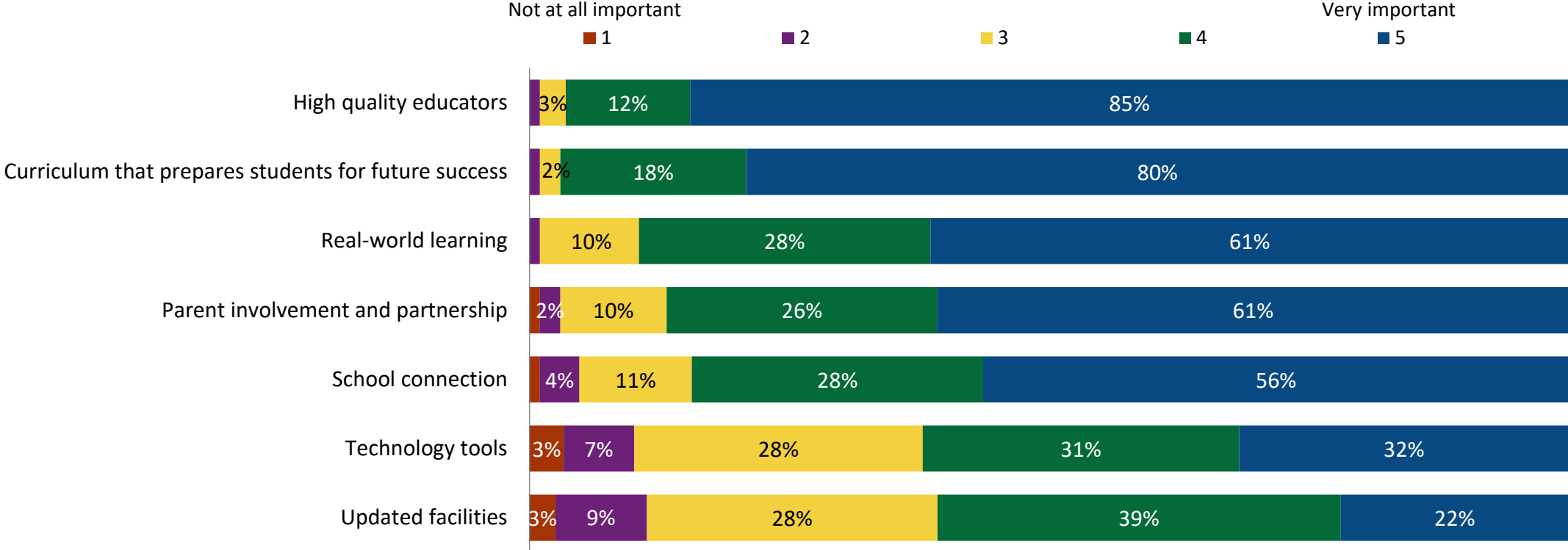

## Importance Rating: Factors Influencing Student Success in Academics



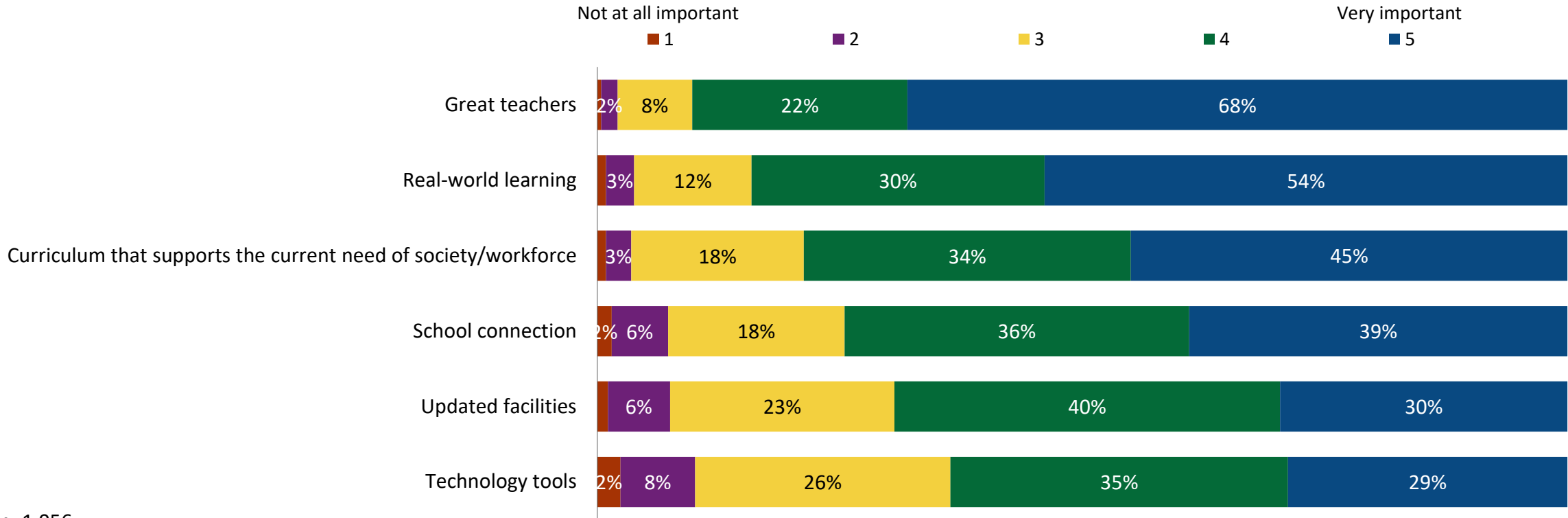

## Importance Rating: Factors Influencing Student Success in Academics

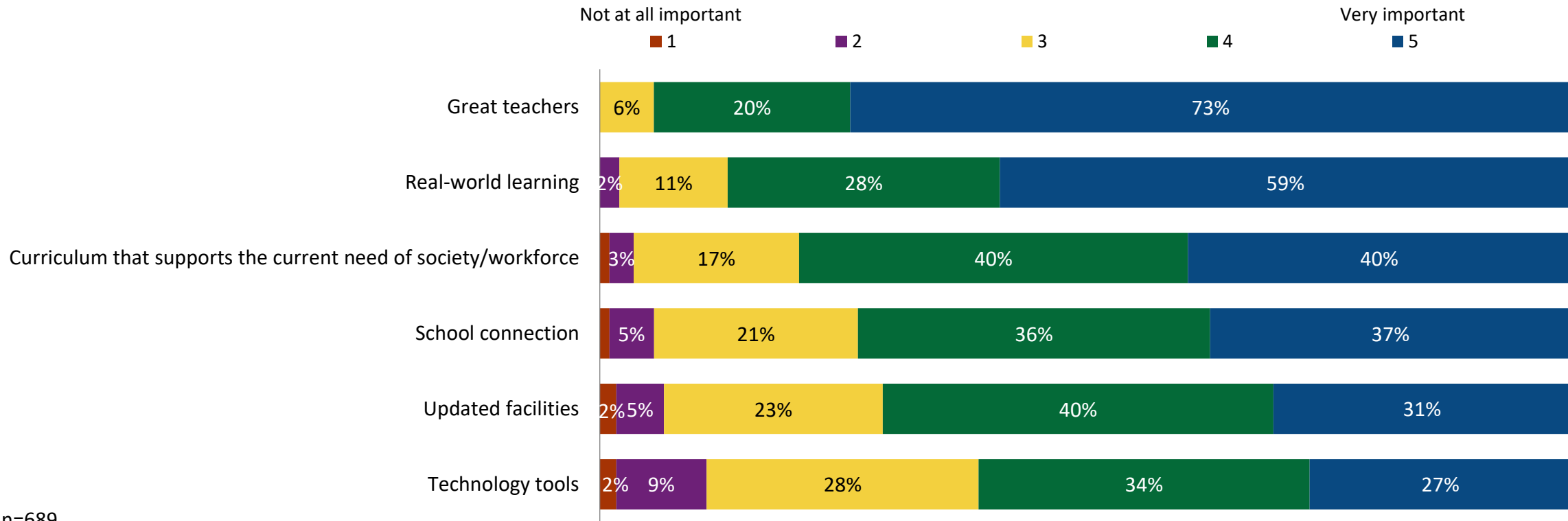


Similar to adults, middle school students rate *teachers* highest among each area listed; however, *real-world learning* rates slightly higher than *curriculum*.

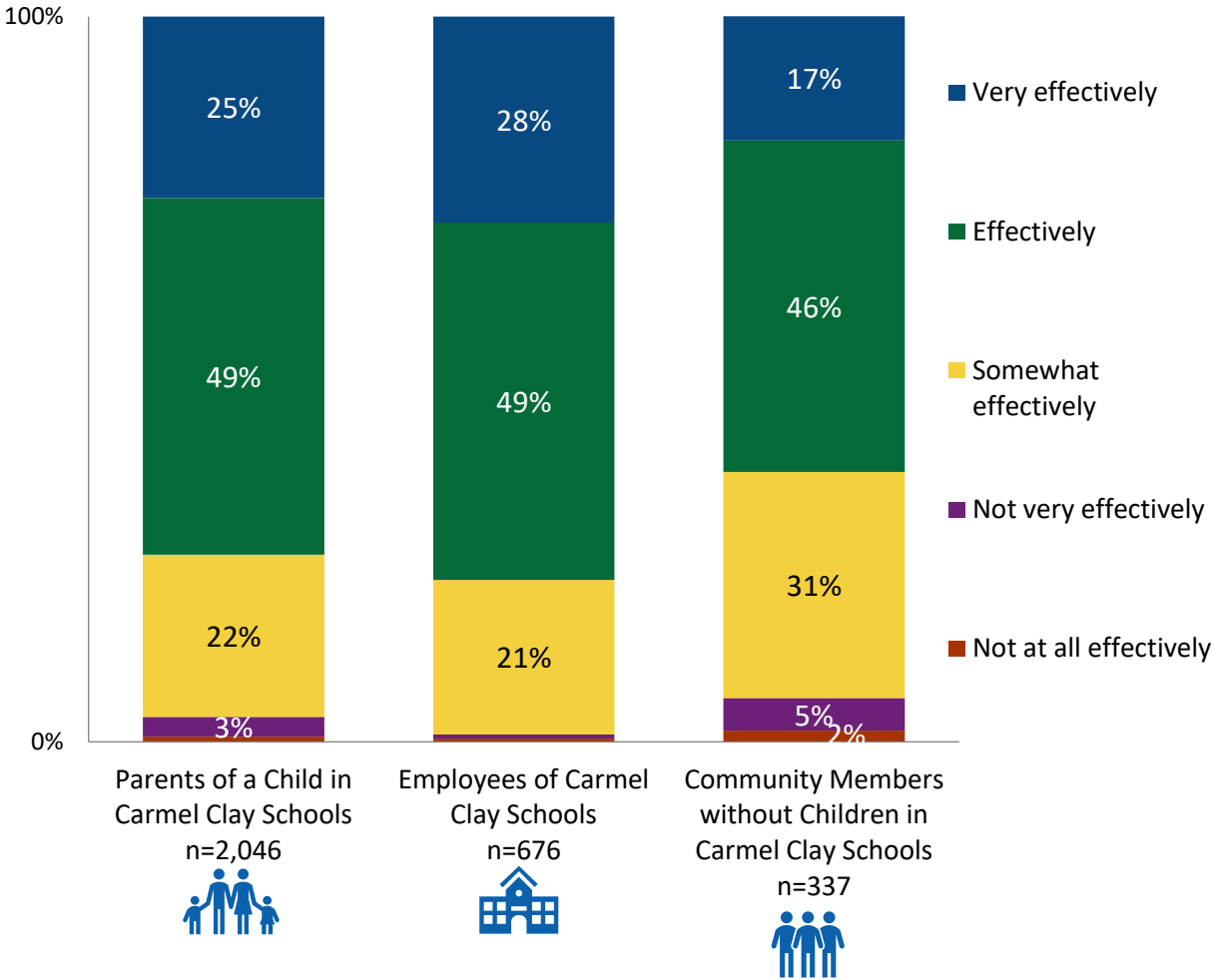

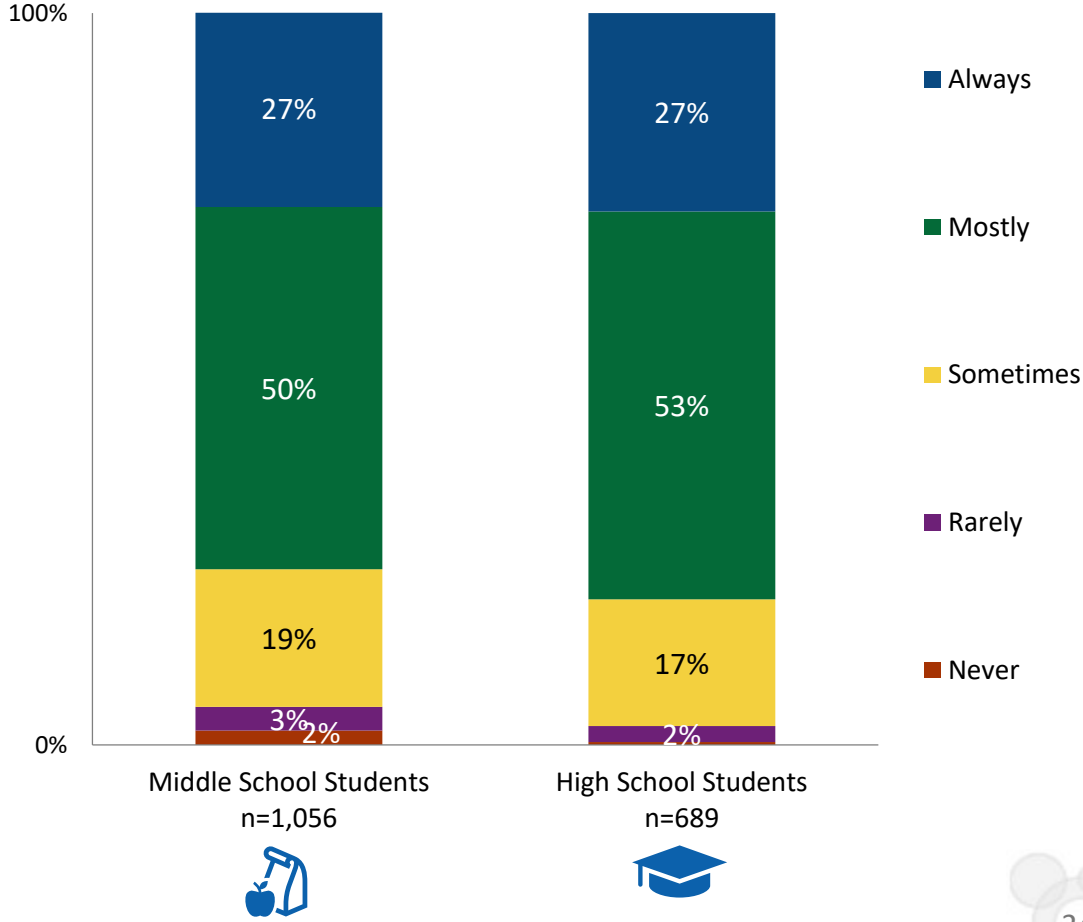
High school students also rate *real-world learning* as important along with *great teachers*.

## Top Three Positive Themes

### **Support for Teachers and Staff**

Many adults and students expressed appreciation for the teachers and their dedication to students.

### **Sense of Community**

Comments highlight a sense of belonging and pride in the schools, fostering a positive environment.

### **High Standards in Education**

Recognition of the high expectations and academic achievements of students within Carmel Clay Schools.

## Top Three Areas for Growth

### **Focus on Middle-range Students**

Adults expressed concerns about ensuring adequate resources and attention for "average" or middle-achieving students.

### **Addressing Student Safety**

Both adults and students raised concerns about safety in schools, specifically regarding school shootings and bullying.

### **Communication and Transparency**

Issues were raised regarding the clarity and timeliness of communication from school administration to parents and the community.



## Executive Summary: Strengths and Opportunities

---

- Of all areas assessed, **academic achievements** is consistently given the highest evaluation among all adult groups.
- **Safety** is another strength of Carmel Clay Schools among adults and students overall; however, community members without children may not be aware of these efforts given their lower rating relative to other groups.
- **Real-world classroom learning** is consistently selected in the top 3 most important items for academic success among adult groups. Students rate real-world learning high on an importance scale, but not consistently selected as one of their top 3 items. This suggests an area to clarify the importance of real-world learning to students.
- **Teacher retention** is an area to explore to further strengthen Carmel Clay School. All groups indicate “Great Teachers” as most important. Most indicate teacher retention is at least meeting expectations; however, it tends to be a lower rated area relative to academics and safety.

# Executive Summary: Respondent Group Differences

---

## Differences Between Adult Groups:

- Generally, the adult groups (parents, employees and community members without children) *relative evaluation* of Carmel Clay Schools' performance and factors that are importance for education are similar.
- However, community members without children in the schools trend lower than employees and parents when evaluating Carmel Clay Schools' performance. This is likely due to a lack of awareness and or lower engagement with the schools compared to the other adult groups.

## Differences Between Middle and High School Students

- Middle and high school students were fairly similar in their responses with a few notable differences:
  - Middle school students evaluate Carmel Clay Schools more positively on *providing mental health needs* than high school students.
  - Middle school students are more likely to indicate *state test scores* as important while high school students are more likely to rate *getting a diploma* as important.

## Differences Between Adults and Students

- Grades and college test scores rank higher in importance for students whereas real-world classroom learning and college credit achievements are top in importance for adults.

**October - December 2024:** Create, develop and implement the CCS Community Survey

**January - February 2025:** Present survey results to the board

**February - April 2025:** Conduct listening sessions / focus groups with the CCS community

**May - June 2025:** Present draft strategic plan to the board based upon community stakeholder feedback

**July - August 2025:** Final 2025-2028 strategic plan to be approved by the board
