- Support nurturing of potentially gifted students at Pamlico County Primary School
- Support implementation of differentiated education plans for identified AIG students at Fred A. Anderson Elementary
- Assist K-5 teachers in designing, implementing, and tracking intervention strategies for struggling students as a part of differentiated core instruction
- Participate in PLC lesson planning for gifted learners in the regular classroom
- Performs other duties as assigned by immediate supervisor
