Purpose

The School Psychologist is responsible for the professional practice and delivery of school psychological services while facilitating learning and promotion of cognitive, social, and personal development of all students.

Qualifications

- Must hold or be eligible to hold a North Carolina Professional Educator License for School Psychologist

Duties and Responsibilities

- Consults with teachers and administrators regarding specific students and/or groups of students
- Works with various school teams to support multi-tiered systems of support for all students within their assigned schools
- Interprets and utilizes data for the purpose of developing appropriate intervention plans for struggling learners within their schools
- Conducts comprehensive psycho-educational evaluations that include but are not limited to the assessment of intellectual, developmental, academic, social/emotional and behavior status
- Provides crisis intervention support for individual students, staff, and school communities when needed
- Performs other duties as assigned by immediate supervisor

Skills and Abilities

- Ability to maintain confidentiality
- Ability to communicate in both written and oral form effectively
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with teachers, administrators, and classified personnel
- Knowledge of the MTSS framework
- Ability to use data to formulate recommendations and to assist in the decision-making process for students

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
