Family Service League, Inc. (DASH)

- Approximately 2,000 guests engaged at DASH since we opened-3/4/2019
- Age Distribution-69% adults, 31 % children and adolescents
- 12% of guests are transported by police
- On average, 40+ calls are fielded a day
- 40 % are referred to mobile crisis or DASH
- Over 1,000 referrals to MCT, since March-completed visits average over 100/mo.

- The Mattituck and RH clinics treated an average of 67 unique NFI clients per month.
- The NFI participating schools made an average of 12 new referrals per month.
- This totaled over 1,000 therapy sessions.
- The initiative is meeting the goals of improving real-time access to care (when needed), decreasing need for emergency department visits and strengthening collaborative relationships and outcomes


