Dear Parents/Guardians:

It has been a great start to the school year! What a joy it has been to see all of your children return to us. Thank you so much for being so positive and supportive of the school. As you know from our summer presentations, our district had to submit plans in case of any scenario that we may face during this school year. You may have read in the news that some neighboring districts have had to utilize their distance learning plans for a day or a period of time until the return was deemed safe. ***At this time, we do not have to utilize this plan, but we wanted you to be aware of what the plan is in case we do.***

If our district does ever have to institute our remote/distance plan, I will alert you via ConnectEd. We will also send all of this information out again. If the district opts to educate remotely at any point this year, ***we will follow our A/B day schedule for secondary:***

- A - Humanities Teachers and some specials teach live classes
- B - STEM Teachers and some specials teach live classes
- Classes will run the regular schedule in 30 minute intervals
- Alternating with live class days, students will be given an asynchronous assignment. Teachers will provide live office hours on those days during class time. Teachers will provide live support to address individual student needs while other students not needing help will complete the assignment on their own.
- Period 1: 8:00 to 8:30; Period 2: 8:30 – 9:00; Period 3: 9:00 – 9:30; Period 4: 9:30 - 10:00; Period 5: 10:00 – 10:30; Period 6: 10:30 – 11:00; Period 7: 11:00 – 11:30; Period 8: 11:30 – 12:00; Period 9 12:00 – 12:30
- A Days: STEM and A Day Specials Student Extra Help: 12:30 – 1:30; Humanities and B Day Specials Extra Help: 1:30 – 2:30
- B Days: Humanities and B Day Specials Student Extra Help: 12:30 – 1:30; STEM and A Day Specials Extra Help: 1:30 – 2:30
- Students are required to attend their classes and will be marked absent if they do not log in.

If the district opts to educate remotely at any point this year, ***we will follow the following elementary schedule:***
