POINTS OF CELEBRATION

- Across all tests for the OST, 26.7% of our students scored advanced or advanced plus, and another 20.2% scored accomplished for the 2023-24 school year.
- In 5 of the 6 tested areas of the OST, WKHS showed significant evidence that the school exceeded student growth expectations for the 2023-24 school year. In four areas, this is the case by a larger magnitude.
- All 8 of our IB diploma candidates completed the requirements and earned scores on their exams to be recognized with the IB Diploma for the 2023-24 school year.

Strategies:

Reading

Deepen staff understanding of the simple view of reading and the importance of treating oral language development as an essential for reading comprehension through the use of interactive read-aloud texts, diverse text sets and high leverage instructional routines outlined for language development (outlined in Shift 1 of Shifting The Balance).

Writing

Expose students to exemplary texts from a variety of sources, including published or professional texts, books and textbooks, the teacher's own writing, and peer samples

Mathematics

Implement instructional environments (math workshop, "thinking classrooms") that allow for differentiation, student engagement, rich mathematical discourse, and scaffolds/supports.

Increase the number of opportunities for students to connect to the community and businesses. Guest speakers, internships, guest conductor, author visit, distance learning with universities/professors, mentors, businesses
