### Allowance Management



- A. A set allowance amount (\$) is approved by Board for each bid group
- B. Use of allowances follows D65 approval process:
  - Review by D65 Staff and TT&H
  - Final approval by CFO T. Mitchell
- C. Requests that exceed approved allowance amount by \$25K or more require Board approval
- D. Requests that exceed approved allowance amount by more than 10% of contract require a re-bid

### **Change Order**

- Bid Group 1, Package 1 with John Keno & Co. for site clearing, site demolitions, and enabling work
- Added stone aggregate needed for ground stabilization and building pad
  - Exceeded the board approved allowance of \$97,300 by \$117,704
- Expense was essential to avoid significant delay and unit rate for stone was set during bid process
- No impact to the overall construction budget
  - Added stone was planned for Bid Package 6, but the unforeseen sinkage required the work to be completed at an earlier stage
