

HARMONY REGIONAL AMBULANCE Scholarship Guidelines

1. All graduating seniors will be eligible to submit a scholarship application with preference given to those who live in Harmony, Cambridge and Wellington.

This scholarship is intended for a student embarking on a career in the medical field. Emergency medicine is favored but it is not a priority or required.

2. The Harmony Regional Ambulance Service (HRAS) Secretary or Representative shall obtain a list of high schools where eligible graduating seniors are attending including home-schooled students from the Principal or other school representative of the Harmony Elementary School, Piscataquis Community High School, Dexter Regional High School and Foxcroft Academy.

Area High Schools will be notified no later than February 1st that the scholarships are available to graduating seniors. The HRAS Secretary or Representative will notify the High Schools by mail or in person with a copy of the scholarship application that can be copied to accommodate the number of interested applicants. The deadline for the application submission will be noted on the application. Applications will be available at the Guidance Office of your school.

3. All applicants must submit the scholarship application by the application deadline to your Guidance Office. Any late applications will not be accepted. Applications will be accepted if postmarked date on the envelope is the same as the application deadline.

4. One scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 (one thousand dollars) will be awarded annually. The HRAS can vote to increase the number of scholarships awarded or may divide the total amount between deserving applicants.

5. Priority consideration will be given to graduating students who are active members of the HRAS.

6. The number of scholarships and the monetary amount of each scholarship will be recommended to the HRAS Membership by the Scholarship Committee and will be voted on by the HRAS Membership at the regularly scheduled monthly meeting in April and no later than the regularly scheduled monthly meeting in May.

7. The HRAS Secretary or its representative shall notify by letter, the High School administration of the appropriate school(s) as to the scholarship recipient(s) and shall instruct said administrator(s) to announce the Harmony Regional Ambulance Service Scholarship award at the appropriate Senior Awards Program and/or Graduation.

8. Scholarship(s) will be paid directly to the recipient(s) upon written proof from the recipient(s) of passing grades at the completion of the first semester and proof of enrollment for the second semester.
