INDIVIDUALIZED HOME INSTRUCTION PLAN – GRADES K – 6

Kindergarten

Kindergarten does not have a required curriculum, although Letter of Intent, IHIP, Quarterly Reports and Year-End Assessments are still necessary. Kindergarten might include: Reading Readiness, Math Readiness, Language Development, Health Education including personal safety and AIDS instruction, Music and Physical Education. In addition, patriotism and citizenship, alcohol/drugs/tobacco abuse, and bicycle/highway safety may be added.

<u>Curriculum Grades 1-6</u> (Required Instruction Hours: 900 per year or 225 per quarter) The suggested times are provided only as a *MODEL* to assist in assessing equivalency:
