Scientific Evidence that SEL Programs Make a Difference

Empathy - Students involved in SEL programs often demonstrate stronger interpersonal skills, such as empathy, communication, and cooperation, fostering a positive classroom environment that encourages learning and collaboration. (Schonert-Reichl, K. A., & Lawlor, M. S. (2010). The effects of a mindfulness-based education program on pre- and early adolescents' well-being and social and emotional competence. Mindfulness, 1(3), 137–151.)

Compassion - When SEL programs are integrated, teachers report a more respectful and collaborative classroom atmosphere, which benefits both academic achievement and emotional well-being. (Greenberg, M. T., Domitrovich, C. E., Weissberg, R. P., & Durlak, J. A. (2017). Social and emotional learning as a public health approach to education. The Future of Children, 27(1), 13-32.)

Scientific Evidence that SEL Programs Make a Difference

Connections - School-based SEL programs have demonstrated that these initiatives consistently increased students' social-emotional skills and positive social behaviors. These programs also reduced behavioral issues and emotional distress, reinforcing students' abilities to form healthy relationships with peers and teachers. Students in SEL programs often experienced enhanced social integration and a better sense of community within their schools. (Durlak, J. A., Weissberg, R. P., Dymnicki, A. B., Taylor, R. D., & Schellinger, K. B. (2011). "The impact of enhancing students' social and emotional learning: A meta-analysis of school-based universal interventions." Child Development, 82(1), 405–432.)

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Purpose - A large-scale study reviewed 424 experimental studies, finding that SEL programs foster a student's sense of purpose by enhancing self-awareness, encouraging goal-setting, and aligning students' actions with their personal values, ultimately promoting meaningful engagement and motivation in school. Dream Projects

- Social-Emotional Growth: These projects align with SEL by fostering confidence, resilience, and a sense of purpose, helping students see themselves as capable of making positive change.
- Future Preparation: By pursuing Dream Projects, students gain experience that prepares them for future academic, career, and personal aspirations.
