Dear Parents/Caregivers:

The Cecil County Public Library is pleased to partner with Cecil County Public Schools to provide CCPS students with a virtual library card account giving students access to:

- Fine-free borrowing for up to five (5) items, including books, audiobooks, and CDs. Items can be checked out from any CCPL branch or delivered directly to your child's school for easy pickup and returns.
- Homework help, including online encyclopedias and research databases.
- CCPL's Digital Library, which includes test preparation tools, eBooks, digital magazines, Mango Languages, and much more.
- The internet and computers in all CCPL branches.

The virtual library card will be issued to students so they can quickly and easily access the library's resources in school, at home, and in the library. If your child already has a traditional library card, they may continue to use it. Your child's virtual library card account is based on their school ID and requires only a few steps to get started.

Although the virtual format is different from our traditional card, the value of holding a library card remains the same. We look forward to continuing this initiative with CCPS to ensure all students have access to materials and resources they need to successfully complete homework assignments, prepare for the SAT, or to simply find something good to read.
