What happens with the information collected?

The Georgia Parent Satisfaction Survey helps to determine parents' perception of the success of parent engagement between the local school and themselves.

The Information gathered as a component of the State Performance Plan, **Indicators 8: Percent of parents with students receiving special education services who report that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving results for children with disabilities.**

The data collected is reported in the Annual Performance Report and on the system profile about each system. Each state is required to conduct a parent survey collection process to measure parent/family needs and perceptions.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is my school asking me to fill out this survey?

In order for all students to graduate prepared to achieve a lifetime of success, families need to be an important part of the school team. To raise success rates for students with disabilities, the Georgia Department of Education asks parents to answer questions to assist local schools in finding ways to partner with families.

Why do they want to know about my child's disability and ethnicity?

Geographic areas, ethnicity, and disability group data are collected to ensure the results are valid and reflect the overall demographics of the state.

Who is being surveyed?

The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is surveying parents of students with disabilities throughout the state of Georgia.

What if I don't understand a question or a term used in a question?

Ask your child's teacher or contact Cherokee County School District Parent Mentor, Jo Ellen Hancock at 770-721-8503.

What if I have more than one child receiving services? Do I fill out more than one survey?

Yes. You will fill out one survey for each child with an IEP. When completing multiple surveys, base your responses on your experience with the individual school serving you child .

Who fills out the survey if parents are divorced and have shared custody?

Most families decide which parent will fill out the survey. Because the surveys go out one to a child, families only get one survey per child.

Does my child's teacher see the survey answers?

No. Your answers are anonymous. Surveys are assigned a coded number-no names.

What if I don't have access to a computer to take the survey; are paper copies available?

No. Families may answer the survey by phone through the Special Education Help Desk at 404-657-9968
