- Registration: You can enroll for Enrichment classes at the following link.
- Payment: The cost for each program will be posted to family Tuition Management Account, and that payment will be automatically deducted on your regularly scheduled Tuition Management payment date.
- Pick-Up: Following class, students who have not been picked up will be taken to Barrie School's Extended Day program. Please reach out to Tim Evans at tevans@barrie.org for students in Grades 1 - 8.

Space is not guaranteed. Drop in rates apply for late pick-ups.

Cancellation and Refunds: If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, families will receive a full refund for their students. Families who wish to remove a student from a program prior to it's start must be done at minimum three business days in advance of the start of that particular program. A partial refund, excluding a \$25 registration fee, will be returned if cancellation is three days prior to the start of that program. There are no refunds for any cancellation after a program has begun. 
