

College Visits

What are college visits?

- Each year, college admissions representatives come to the International School between mid-September and early November. In Fall 2024, we hosted nearly 50 visits.
- An admissions officer from a college meets with interested 11th and 12th grade students, gives a brief overview of the college, and answers questions.
- Visits last 30-45 minutes and are typically in the library during school hours. Most visits are in person, but we offer the option to meet virtually.

Why should you sign up for college visits?

- Fastest, cheapest, and easiest way to learn about a lot of colleges and college types (small, big, medium, liberal arts, research universities, rural urban and suburban locations). Helps you begin to figure out what kinds of colleges interest you/narrow your list!
- It's an opportunity to ask detailed questions that are specific to your interests.
- Meet the admissions officer that, in many cases, reviews your application for admission.
