

Organization of Instruction

The Board of Education shall provide a system of education extending from kindergarten through grade 12. It also is responsible for special education for handicapped children.

The schools of the district shall be organized to present a unified program of instruction and shall be operated as a single system under the direction of the superintendent.

The grouping and housing of instructional levels in school facilities shall be in accordance with what is commonly called the K-5; 6-8; 9-12 plan. Under this plan, the kindergarten and first five grades will be the elementary school; the middle school will contain grades 6, 7 and 8, and the high school will contain grades 9, 10 11 and 12.
