VOLUNTEERS

It is the desire of the Weld County RE-9 School District to encourage parents and members of the community to offer volunteer services to the school. It is at the same time a top priority of the District to take reasonable measures to maintain the safety of its children.

All persons providing on-going volunteer services will be required to submit a written application to the District which specifies services to be rendered to the District (see IJOC-E-1) and authorize a background check, the cost of which will be paid for by the district.

To encourage volunteerism, background checks may be required for parents/guardians of children attending Ault schools who chaperone field trips or occasionally assist the Parent Teacher Organizations. If volunteering in this capacity becomes on-going back ground check will be required.

Because of the nature of locker room supervision and the close contact coaches have with athletes, all persons wishing to offer services as a volunteer coach in an athletic program will be requested to submit fingerprints and to authorize a background check, the cost of which will be paid for by the District.
