

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BILLINGS ELEMENTARY  
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 AND BILLINGS HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2,  
YELLOWSTONE COUNTY**

**TO SELL/DISPOSE OF DISTRICT PERSONAL PROPERTY**

**Date of Adoption: January 27, 2025**

Whereas, the Boards of Trustees of Billings Elementary School District No. 2, Yellowstone County, and Billings High School District No. 2, Yellowstone County, (collectively, the Board and the School District) hold in trust all real and personal property of the School District; MCA § 20-6-602;

Whereas, the Board is authorized under Montana law to sell or otherwise dispose of School District property that is or is about to become abandoned, obsolete, undesirable, or unsuitable for school purposes; MCA § 20-6-604;

Whereas, the Board must follow a certain procedure to sell or otherwise dispose of School District property, including the adoption of a property disposal resolution and notice of any such resolution; any such resolution is subject to appeal by a taxpayer under Montana law; MCA § 20-6-604;

Whereas, once the legal appeal period has passed after the adoption of such a resolution or the resolution, if appealed, has been upheld by a court, the Board may sell or dispose of the property subject to such a resolution in any reasonable manner that the Board determines to be in the best interests of the School District; MCA § 20-6-604; and

Whereas, the items of personal property listed on the attachment to this Resolution, limited to those items purchased and still considered property of the School District, have been reviewed by the School District Superintendent and are proposed to the Board as being abandoned, obsolete, undesirable, or unsuitable for the school purposes of the School District.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Board hereby determines that the items of personal property listed on the attachment to this Resolution, limited to those purchased by the District and still considered property of the School District, are or are about to become abandoned, obsolete, undesirable, or unsuitable for school purposes;

It is further resolved that the Superintendent is authorized to otherwise dispose of the property listed on the attachment to the extent that said property is the property of the School District. The Superintendent is allowed to otherwise dispose of the property amounting to instructional materials, including textbooks, library books, and other curricular materials.

It is further resolved that the Clerk shall provide notice of this Resolution as required by Montana law; and

It is further resolved that this Resolution shall not be effective and the property subject to this Resolution shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of until the appeal period provided for in Montana law as passed; MCA § 20-6-604(2).
