Student Discipline (Habitually Disruptive Students-High School)

For those instances of misdirected behavior which may add up to labeling a student as habitually disruptive, the following process will be used to deter the behavior from mounting:

- 1. First through third offense Possible reprimand, detention, restriction from activities, Saturday school or out-of-school suspension.
- 2. Fourth offense One to three days out-of-school suspension plus remedial plan
- 3. Fifth offense One to five days out-of-school suspension plus remedial plan
- 4. Sixth offense Recommendation for expulsion

Suspensions for more serious violations will be assigned as prescribed by Board policy and state law. In lieu of suspension, a parent or guardian may elect to attend school with his student for the prescribed suspension with the consent of the student teachers.
