IDENTIFY CONCERNS

SET A GOAL

We will use a RealCare® Simulator baby to demonstrate how to change a disposable diaper, how to pick it up, swaddle, and use a car seat.

ACT



We recorded the video on December 6th at Kaytlin's house. We got the RealCare® Simulator baby from one of our FCS teachers and gathered supplies for the baby. We then pretended not to know how to do certain tasks of taking care of a baby and alternated demonstrating the task to one another with detail. After recording we then edited the clips together and published it to our school website and presented it to some FCS classes such as human growth.

FOLLOW UP



Our goal was met and we hope it will help combat our concern of people not knowing how to handle a baby. We finished our video with good time and were able to retake and edit some parts to improve it. However, if we were to do it again, we would use a better camera and better sound quality. If we got more time we would also include how to change a cloth diaper in the rare case someone has to deal with it. We appreciate our FCS teacher who was able to help us get supplies for the video and who taught us fundamentals of baby care years ago.
