## Agua Fria High School

**Project Cost: \$18.25m**

Anticipated completion: **August 2022**

## Desert Edge High School

**Project cost: \$3m**

Anticipated completion: **August 2022**

A new 5,600-square-foot Welcome Center and Student Services building will help connect students and visitors to the campus.




## Millennium High School

**Project Cost: \$18.6m**

Anticipated completion: **April 2022**

The students and community will soon have building renovations that include band and choir rooms and a new state-of-the-art gymnasium that not only accommodates PE classes and athletics, but is also open for extra-curricular activities and community-based events.



## Transportation and Warehouse Facility

**Project Cost: \$12m**

Anticipated completion: **Fall 2022**

This new facility will feature six service bays, storage, a central distribution warehouse, and parking for buses and fleet vehicles. This project will save taxpayer dollars by centralizing transportation and thereby reducing maintenance costs.
